5.1 ANNUAL PLAN 2007-08

Planning Commission approved a Plan size of Rs.1455 crore for the Annual Plan 2007-08 for the Union Territory of Puducherry. The major head of development wise approved outlay is as follows:

5.2 Resources for funding the Plan Programmes

It is anticipated that ARM of Rs.271 crore, Reimbursement of CST collections of Rs.185 crore, Net Market Borrowings of Rs.178 crore, Financial Assistance from Government of India, other Tsunami Rehabilitation Programme of Rs.180 crore and other Central Assistance of Rs.150 crore are likely to be realized in the current financial year.

5.3 Net Small Savings

As against the small savings loan of Rs.180 crore, only Rs.20 crore is likely to be realized in the current year as small savings collections have decline sharply throughout the country. Hence, Ministry of Finance, Government of India was requested to allows UT Administration to raise loan to an extent of Rs.160 crore as Additional Open Market Borrowing (AOMB). Government approval have been accorded under Article 293(3) of the Constitution of India. Thus, total Market Borrowing for the current year for funding the Plan programmes will be of order Rs.337 crore (Rs.170 crore + Rs.160 crore).

5.4 Negotiated Loan (HUDCO)

The following projects were earlier proposed for implementation with loan assistance from HUDCO amounting to Rs.247.00 crore.

Subsequently a decision was taken to implement the sewerage project to cover remaining urban areas of Puducherry and construction of tenements under Slum upgradation programme under JNNURM. Remaining projects are to be implemented with loan assistance from HUDCO.

While delegating powers to Lt. Governor of this Union Territory to borrow funds, **the following conditions** were laid down by the Ministry of Home Affairs to avail loan assistance from Financial Institutions.

- (a) At the time of plan projection for any one year, the Government of Puducherry will have to exercise diligence that Plan loans + Open market Borrowings + Small Savings Loans + Negotiated loans less prepayments do not result in a debt stock twice its anticipated level of revenue.
- (b) The consolidated debt of the Government of Puducherry, including the outstanding guarantees, should not exceed 20% of GSDP (Gross State Domestic Product) of Puducherry.
- (c) The guarantees shall not be given for financially unviable ventures which may result in a financial loss to the Central Government.
- (d) The total level of the outstanding guarantees shall be in no case exceed the monetary limits as may be specified by the Central Government from time to time as per the recommendations made by the Technical Committee on State Guarantees set up by the Reserve Bank of India; and
- (e) A statement of guarantees will be prepared and included in the Annual Budget of the Government of the Union Territory of Puducherry.

Since total loan liability of Union Territory of Puducherry exceeds 20% of GSDP it became necessary to make a reference to Government of India for their approval to avail loan assistance from HUDCO. Approval is yet to be given by Ministry of Home Affairs for availing the loan assistance from HUDCO.

5.5 World Bank Loan Assistance for Tsunami Reconstruction Programme (ETRP)

World Bank loan amounting to Rs.185 crore (provisional) was agreed for **Tsunami reconstruction programme** to be implemented by the Project Implementing Agency, an umbrella organization created for this purpose. Rs.75 crore was earlier released by the World Bank in the year 2005-06 which is yet to be fully utilized. Hence allocation of Rs.110 crore by the World Bank for the Tsunami Reconstruction Programme (ETRP) may not materialise in the current year.

5.6 JNNURM

Planning Commission approved Rs.71.17 crore for **JNNURM programme** in our Union Territory. Funds under this programme will be recommended by Ministry of Urban Development to Ministry of Finance on fulfilling the following conditions:

- a) State Level Nodal Agency to correspond with the Mission Directorates of MoUD and MoHUPA, GOI has to be notified;
- b) State Level Steering Committee for approving and monitoring the projects under the scheme has to be constituted:
- c) A City development Plan to identify the demand and supply gap of the infrastructure facilities and to chart out the City Investment Plan has to be prepared and approved by the State Level Steering Committee and Central Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee of the Ministry;
- d) Detailed project Reports in line with the CDP for under taking projects that optimizes the life cycle cost of the projects has to be prepared and approved by the State Level Steering Committee and Central Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee of the Ministry; and

e) Memorandum of Agreement to bring in the stipulated mandatory / optional reforms in urban Governance within a time line frame works has to be signed.

The Town and Country Planning Department has been designated as Nodal department for JNNURM projects in our Union Territory and they have completed the exercise on 31.12.2007.

The following projects have been recommended for release of funds under JNNURM Projects.

It is now communicated by the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India that Rs.50.11 crore will be released under JNNURM to the UT of Puducherry in the current year.

Thus the Plan size may be reduced to Rs.1076.94 crore in case World Bank Loan Assistance of Rs.110 crore and HUDCO loan assistance of Rs.247 crore do not materialize in the current year. The details are as follows:

5.7 Likely achievements for the Annual Plan 2007-08

Agriculture

- ➤ One Uzhavar Sandhai, one Rural Market and one Rural Godown will be established.
- ➤ Horticulture Sales Centre will be established.
- Soil Health card / Green leaf card will be issued to 3000 farmers.

Animal Husbandry

- ➤ 1,25,000 frozen semen straw will be procured for artificial insemination.
- ➤ 30,000 Girirani/Giriraja chicks and 5000 turkey poults) will be distributed.

Fisheries

- ➤ 2000 nos. of fishermen will be supplied with life saving appliances and 500 nos. of ice box at free of cost.
- ➤ 2 nos. of aquarium each at Karaikal and Mahe will be established.
- ➤ 21,000 fishermen families will be given 100 kgs. of rice and Rs.750 per family during fishing ban period.

Forestry and Wildlife

- > Setting up of mangrove interpretation center at Puducherry and Yanam.
- > Setting up of 2 nos. of watch tower at Puducherry.

Co-operation

- ➤ Release of Share Capital Assistance to PACBs and Primary Agricultural Cooperative Credit Society.
- ➤ Share Capital Assistance to Pondicherry Co-operative Sugar Mills.

REAP

- Young Energy Guards (YEG) club will be established in schools & colleges.
- Municipal solid waste to coal project will be taken up in three municipalities.

Community Development

- It is proposed to take up 134 No. of works in all the ten commune panchayats.
- ➤ Acquisition of land for construction of office building for Directorate of Rural Development.
- ➤ 230 Groups will be given Revolving fund assistance of Rs.15.00 lakhs each.

Minor Irrigation

- Construction of treatment plant for purifying the drainage water polluting the Sankaraparani river.
- Construction of coastal protection wall in Pattinacherry, Karukkalacherry, Akkaraivattam, Vakku Vanjore and Keezhavanjore in Karaikal region.
- Formation of Mini lakes at Paduthar Kollai, Pathakudy and Andoor.

Power

- ➤ It is proposed to commission 93 nos. of new distribution transformers of various capacities and enhance the capacity of 51 nos. of existing distribution transformers.
- ➤ It is proposed to connect 8000 nos. of domestic services 1200 nos. of commercial services, 35 nos. of agricultural services.
- ➤ 1345 nos. of new street lights were also proposed to be energized during this period.

Industries

- ➤ It is proposed to set up Silk Villages with Silk Weaving Units and Coir Village in Puducherry.
- ➤ To make the industry sustainable, Transport subsidy and Power subsidy, Fuel Subsidy, Foreign Trade Subsidy & Infrastructure subsidy are proposed.

Ports

- ➤ It is proposed to undertake conversion of metre gauge railway sidings at the Old Port into Broad Gauge.
- > Puducherry and Karaikal ports will be developed.

Roads & Bridges

- ➤ Construction of retaining wall and widening of road from Kuruvinatham to Soriankuppam in B.C.
- ➤ Construction of 'U' drain at Thavalakuppam in Ariyakuppam commune Pondicherry.
- ➤ Construction of Sub way near JIPMER.
- Construction of a Regulator Cum Bridge at Mahe.
- Land Acquisition of Western Byepass road in Karaikal.
- > Reconstruction of existing old bridge across Guduvaiyar near Uruvaiyar village.
- > Construction of high level bridge across Tenpennaiyar river across Sooriankuppam and Manamedu.

Transport

Establishment of Transport complexes with testing yard and other facilities is proposed. It is proposed to release share contribution to Southern Railways for laying new railway line between Karaikal and Nagoor; Tindivanam and Cuddalore. Road safety week will be celebrated.

Scientific Research

➤ Pondicherry Council for Science & Technology (PCS & T) will be strengthened by release of GIA and a Science Park, Stationary Planetarium and a Sky Watching Centre in Puducherry will be established under the auspices of PCS &T.

Ecology and Environment

A monitoring and an assessment cell to assess the performance rate of the industries on the basis of the pollution standards and suitably rate them into various categories by providing separate colour codings will be set up.

Tourism

- ➤ Land Bank scheme (Acquisition of land of various places in UT of Puducherry)
- > Purchase of water sports equipments.
- > Flood lighting of Churches/Temples/Mosques.

Statistics

➤ Units such as State Income, Industrial Statistics, Economic Survey and Evaluation Cell will be revamped and strengthened.

Information Technology and e-Governance

- > PSWAN will be established.
- Consultants for various IT related activities will be appointed.
- ➤ State Data Centre, Rajiv Gandhi Knowledge Park, Jawahar Knowledge Centre will be set up.
- ➤ Common Service Center (Puducherry 67, Karaikal 22, Mahe 6 and Yanam 5) to deliver Govt, services to citizens will be established.

Civil Supplies

- Financial assistance will be provided to Puducherry Engineering college for setting up of Petrol testing Laboratory.
- ➤ LPG connection with a stove and one Cylinder will be supplied to 10,000 BPL families at free of cost.
- ➤ It is proposed to supply groceries at subsidized cost under Public Distribution system to all BPL families.

School Education

- ➤ Universalisation of Secondary Education by 2012.
- ➤ Conversion of existing State Training Centre (STC) into State Council of Education, Research and Training (SCERT).

- Construction of Central Kitchen two at Karaikal and 1 at Mahe.
- ➤ To provide toilet facilities for boys and girls separately in all the Govt. School and it will be completed on war footing. Similarly adequate water supply will be ensured in all the govt. schools.

Higher & Technical Education

- New courses viz, M.Phil (Corporate course) and Part time P.hd. (Home Science) will be started at Bharathidasan Govt. College for Women.
- ➤ B.Sc. (Bio-chemistry) will be started in Arignar Anna Govt. Arts College, Karaikal.

- ➤ Land will be acquired for setting up of Puducherry State University at Puducherry.

Health

- ➤ It is proposed to construct new buildings to accommodate the Sub Centres & PHCs functioning in rented buildings.
- Construction of Directorate complex which will have administrative office / Programme Office of Health Department will be taken up.
- Construction of a new 500 bedded multi speciality hospital will be taken up at Karaikal, construction of a Trauma care facility and Critical Care Wards will be taken up in the General Hospital, Mahe.
- ➤ In order to facilitate 100% institutional deliveries to the pregnant mothers
- ➤ It is proposed to establish First Referral Centres in the rural areas of U.T. of Puducherry.
- A community Health Insurance Scheme will be commissioned initially in the outlying regions of Mahe and Yanam.

Water Supply and Sanitation

- Construction of office room and store room in the ground floor and first floor of the Uppalam OHT.
- ➤ Sinking borewell at Kundupalayam and surrounding areas. Construction of 20 lakhs litres capacity OHT at Thanthaiperiyar nagar, Puducherry.
- ➤ Construction of an OHT and sump at Angalamana Nagar pumping station site to distribute the water for the area of Ganesh nagar, Angalamman nagar, VOC nagar, Kuruchikuppam, Vaithikuppam, Vazhaikulam, and the surrounding area at Muthialpet Puducherry.

- Acquisition of land for construction of pumphouse and borewell at various places in Kizhoor, Sivaranthagam, and Sathamangalam Village.
