

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**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF TECHNICAL STEERING COMMITTEE**  
**HELD ON 09/02/2022**

The second meeting of the Technical Steering Committee was held on 09/02/2022 at 3.00 p.m. under the Chairmanship of the Development Commissioner-cum-Principal Secretary (Finance) at the VC hall of Chief Secretariat to review the status of setting up of Unified Data Hub in U.T. of Puducherry. Committee members and special invitees have attended the meeting. List of participants are given in the Annexure.

During the meeting, the important points discussed as per agenda are as follows.

- The Chairman advised the Director of Accounts and Treasuries to collect the Aadhaar details of Government servants in the data base including retired Government employees.
- Aadhaar seeded Birth and Death data of LAD should be integrated with base data of Civil Supplies Department.
- The Commissioner of Transport Department has informed that 90% of vehicle registration have been linked with Aadhaar. There is no problem in sharing data with UDH.
- The benefits are disbursed to disability person according to the percentage of disability by Social Welfare Department. These data should be synchronized with the mother data of Civil Supplies Department to avoid duplication.
- The Sr. Technical Director informed that three requirements have been identified as the major objectives of the Unified Data Hub.
  1. Online validation
  2. De-duplication
  3. Cross references with multiple departments.
