- 2. Director (Planning), Planning & Research Department shall co-ordinate the functioning of the Committee.
- 3. The objective of the Committee shall be to monitor the Central Sector Projects costing more than Rs. 150.00 crore implemented in the U.T. of Puducherry. Identify major factors for large scale time over-run like delays in land acquisition, delays in getting environment/forest/wildlife clearances, delay in shifting of utilities, delays in removal of encroachments, law & order problems, inaccurate/incomplete revenue records, agitation by local pressure groups, lack of co-ordination between different Departments in resolving issues, lack of supporting/facilitating infrastructure like approaches to project sites, etc.

- 4. The High Powered Committee would meet once in a quarter, with the agenda to sort out bottlenecks in timely implementation of Central Sector Projects costing more than Rs. 150.00 core and to monitor their implementation with regard to time and cost over-runs and to suggest any systematic as well as other improvements which would enable timely completion of Projects and within the cost.
- 5. The Committee shall meet atleast once in a quarter or whenever the necessity arises. The Committee may also take-up any other issues which are relevant with the permission of the Chair.
