#### ROAD TRANSPORT

The Government Automobile Workshop is the centralised service department in the Union Territory of Pondicherry for maintenance of all government vehicles. This department also supplies fuel and lubricants to government vehicles, engine generators, kitchen equipment functioning in government departments as well as quasi government agencies and central government departments. This Department is also taking up apprentices for training in motor vehicle maintenance, mechanical works and welding.

Transport department proposes to establish check posts to strictly enforce and implement Motor Vehicle Act and to increase revenue collection. It is also proposed to set up a road safety cell for conducting awareness programme, seminars, etc. It is also proposed to release matching grant to Railway Board for conversion of meter gauge line into broad gauge line and for laying new lines to the UT of Pondicherry.
