EDUCATION

The Tenth Plan must establish specific and monitorable targets for a few key indicators of human development and accordingly the following monitorable targets in respect of Education sector have been indicated for the Tenth Five Year Plan:-

- * Universal access to primary education by 2007
- * Increase in Literacy rates to 72% by 2007 and to 80% by 2012.

As per the 2001 census (provisional) figure the literacy rate in the Union Territory of Pondicherry is 81.49 as against the National average of 65.38 and has been placed under category-IV which includes the States and Union Territories having literacy rate 75% and above. The Union Territory of Pondicherry is in the 7th place in the ranking of literacy rate. Hence, the task before this Union Territory is to ensure universal access to primary education and to achieve 90% literacy rate by the end of Tenth Plan and 100% literacy rate by 2012. As such, the most important objective of primary education is to sustain the growth so far the Tenth Plan in respect of achieved and also to strengthen the process of achieving cent percent growth rate in literacy within the stipulated period. To achieve the above goal, the new programme called Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan will be implemented as per Government of India guidelines. In spite of rapid growth of education in terms of quantity and literacy rate, the quality aspect of education should also be given priority. Our aim, should therefore, be not only to increase the enrolment but also to improve the standards of education in Government Schools.

During the Ninth Plan, existing elementary schools were strengthened by providing teaching aids, equipments, furniture, chalk pieces, maps and charts, etc. Additional classes have been opened and necessary teaching and non-teaching posts were created. 275 thatched sheds were converted into pucca buildings. A new central Kitchen was constructed at Kurusukuppam, Pondicherry.

99,800 students were given free supply of text books, stationery, footwear and two sets of terry cotton uniform, shoes and socks were also given at free of cost to preprimary students and two washing soaps have been provided to poor students studying in Govt. and Govt. aided schools. 3 Govt. Primary Schools and 12 Govt. Middle Schools were upgraded to the next higher standards. 14,775 OEBC students were awarded pre-matric Scholarships. 1104 poor students were provided with incentive awards. 103 post graduate students were given financial assistance. 18 students top ranked in X and +2 final examination were given assistance. Ten Teachers and ten Headmasters were benefitted under cash award scheme. 1,250 school drop-outs have been covered under Non-Formal Education. 3 Mini Bal bhavans were opened and Bala kala mela and National camp for children were conducted. 60 In-Service training to teachers were conducted. 1381 students have been imparted coaching for various competitive examinations.13 students were given studentship/fellowship in Tamil/Telugu/Malayalam/French.

Under Sports and Games, in order to develop physical activities of the students, All India Civil Service Tournament, Youth Festival, Coaching scheme, childrens rally, Bala Kala Mela etc., were conducted. Besides, Annual Sports Day functions were conducted

in all schools and prizes were distributed. Good quality sports articles were supplied to all students for participation in Inter-State Tournaments and Inter-Regional Tournaments. For Development of sports, Grants were released to Pondicherry Sports council, Rajiv Gandhi School of Sports and Youth Hostel. Indira Gandhi Stadium at Uppalam was provided with flood lighting to conduct Football and other games. Under Collegiate Education, 17 new courses were started in various colleges functioning in the U.T. Pondicherry. A Rural college was started at Madagadipet, Pondicherry. Infrastructural facilities have been provided to all colleges. B. Ed. college at Karaikal and an Arts and Science College at Kadirkamam, Pondicherry were started through the registered societies. Under Technical Education, PIPMATE was provided with assistance in the form of grant-in-aid so as to maintain the three polytechnics covered under Technical Education Programme.

During the Tenth Plan, with the objective of giving a proper recognition to early childhood education which is the first step in the total educational continuum, it is proposed to introduce pre-primary education to all children in the age group of 3+ by starting pre-primary sections (LKG) in 253 Government Primary Schools. In order to cover the habitation with more than 300 population, it is proposed to start primary schools in 29 habitations which includes opening of 12 new primary schools in SC predominant habitations. For ensuring qualitative education rather than quantitative increase, it is proposed to either amalgamate the primary schools having poor student strength with nearby primary schools or close down these unviable schools. Even though much progress has been achieved in providing infrastructural facilities, considerable classrooms are run in thatched sheds. Hence the priority during Tenth Plan will be to convert all the thatched shed classrooms into pucca building and also provision of drinking water and sanitation facility to all schools. Matching contribution will be made for Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan Programme under State Plan. In order to remove regional imbalance and maintain the ratio of 2:1 between primary and middle school and also to open the door of upper primary education to more students, 20 primary schools spreading over in all four regions will be upgraded to middle Schools. To cope up with the increasing demand, it is proposed to upgrade ten number of middle schools into high schools and six high schools into higher secondary schools in the Tenth Plan. In order to develop separate curriculum based on current trend a Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education will be set up with required staff and other infrastructural facilities.

Presently, vocational courses are in operation in 19 Hr.Sec.Schools out of 35 Hr. Sec. Schools situated in Pondicherry and Karaikal regions. Vocational courses are to be introduced in the remaining 16 higher secondary schools during the Tenth Plan period. Besides introducing vocational courses in 16 Hr.Sec.Schools, a separate technical Hr.Sec.School is proposed to be started in Karaikal region.

Under the Collegiate education field, it has become necessary to introduce / restructure some of the existing courses in the Arts and Science colleges and to modernize and computerize the libraries in all the colleges. The establishment of a separate Directorate of Technical and Higher (Collegiate) Education in the context of enlarging / strengthening the Technical Education, administering and monitoring the implementation of various technical and academic education programmes and promotion of industry institution interaction. Hence, a separate Directorate of

Technical and higher (Collegiate) Education will be set up during the Tenth Plan. Six technical institutions, 11 Arts and Science Colleges and one College of Education will come under the control of the proposed Directorate. In Pondicherry Engineering College, two new M. Tech. Courses in Distributed computing system (Computer Science) and Drives and Controls (Electrical & Electronics) will be started. Besides new buildings will be constructed. Two new Diploma courses in Information Technology and Electronics and Instrumentation Engineering will be started during the Tenth Plan. The PIPMATE will be assisted in the form of additional grant to maintain four Polytechnics under its control and also to construct new building for Mahe Polytechnic.

In order to enable the students to become talented sportsmen, various sports activities will be encouraged and more and more coaching camps in selected games will be conducted. Youth festival and children's rally will be conducted in all regions to create awareness on the importance about sports and other extra-curricular activities. To encourage sports in rural areas, mini stadiums will be set up in each commune by acquiring required land. The Indoor stadium at Uppalam will be developed to have facilities for more indoor games. Building with auditorium for Rajiv Gandhi School of sports will be constructed. It is also proposed to introduce Yoga Education in all schools.

During the Tenth Plan, a separate complex is proposed at a cost of Rs.9.06 crore at Kalapet for Law College. Land has already been acquired. Preliminary works are being undertaken. The complex will consist of administrative block, library, examination/research block, academic block, auditorium etc.

The schemes under Art & Culture envisage granting of awards / medals to literary persons and artists living in indigent circumstances, conducting cultural and literacy festivals, releasing grants to Pondicherry Institute of Linguistic & Culture which conducts research projects / seminars / workshops on linguistic studies and also to Bharathiar Palkalai Koodam which impart education at degree level in visual arts, like music, dance etc., In addition to these ongoing schemes, a new scheme namely "Promotion of traditional martial and heroic arts is included which envisages the extension of financial assistance to the schools / institutions which train youth in martial and heroic arts such as kalari fight, silambam etc. Romain Rolland Library will be computerised with all amenities. Further, it is proposed to set up multi purpose modern auditorium in Pondicherry. Construction of Bharathi Manimandapam, administrative blocks and class rooms for Bharathiar Palkalaikoodam at Ariankuppam is also proposed.
