#### WELFARE OF BACKWARD CLASSES

During the Ninth Plan, 178000 students were benefited by the supply of text books, stationeries and two sets of uniforms. 10954 Students were benefited by prematric scholarship. Opportunity Cost was paid to 20158 parents of SC students. Free clothing items were supplied to 320000 SC People. 1012 free house site pattas were distributed to homeless SC people. Providing free tutorial facilities had benefited 41616 SC students. Financial assistance was released to 2732 brides and pregnant and lactating mothers. Construction subsidy was given to 420 SC homeless people. Grant-in-aid was released to local bodies for taking up 91 civic works and construction of 10 community halls. Free distribution of bicycles was made to 6294 SC boys and girls students. In 24 boys and girls hostels are functioning in all the three regions and 9770 students were benefited. 256 SC women were given vocational training.

During the Tenth Plan, it is proposed to cover 1,75,000 students by supply of text books, stationeries and two sets of uniforms. All the existing 24 hostels will be maintained. Apart from this, it is proposed to start seven more hostels so as to benefit 3500 students. Presently, ten hostels are functioning in own buildings and the rest in private buildings, where facilities are not fully available. It is therefore proposed to provide own building for the fourteen hostels as well as seven new hostels that are to be started. 27500 SC girls students would be benefited by opportunity cost. It is proposed to cover 275000 SC beneficiaries for free supply of clothing items. 500 homeless SC people will be allotted free house site pattas and given housing subsidy. Fifteen community halls and ten toilet blocks will be constructed in the rural areas through Commune Panchayats. It is also proposed to give financial assistance to 1750 SC poor brides and 3000 pregnant and lactating women. By extending coaching and allied facilities, 66000 SC students will be benefited. About 19250 SC students will be given pre-matric scholarships. Bicycles will be distributed to about 18173 SC boys and girls students. 320 SC women will be given vocational training. It is proposed to enhance the rates of various incentives extended to the SC community during the Tenth Plan.

During the Annual Plan 2002-03, 35000 students will be covered by the supply of text books, stationery and two sets of uniforms. 5000 SC girl students will be benefited by opportunity cost. 33,000 SC beneficiaries will be covered by free supply of clothing items. 100 homeless persons will be allotted free house site pattas. Three Community Halls and two toilet blocks will be constructed. It is proposed to benefit 350 SC poor brides and 600 pregnant & lactating women. It is also proposed to cover 12000 SC students by provision of coaching and allied facilities. About 3484 SC students will be awarded pre-matric scholarships. It is proposed to release housing subsidy to cover 100 beneficiaries. Bicycles will be distributed to 3290 SC boys and girls students. 64 SC women will be given vocational training.

A State Level Commission for Backward Classes has been constituted under the Chairmanship of Justice A. Thangamani, a retired High Court Judge of Chennai. This Committee will identify among other things the Most Backward Classes and recommend the list to Government. Equity share capital is proposed to be paid to the National Backward Class Finance and Development Corporation and National Minorities Finance and Development Corporation.
