## DAIRY DEVELOPMENT

Under Dairy Development programmes, the main objectives are to improve the socio-economic conditions of milk producers, to maintain effective supply system at reasonable price and to provide subsidiary occupation to farmers. 92 Primary Cooperatives which are in Pondicherry are supplying milk by affiliating them with the Pondicherry Cooperative Milk Producers` Union and Primaries in the Karaikal are supplying milk to the Karaikal Cooperative Milk supply society. Under operation flood III the Pondicherry Dairy was expanded to handle 50000 litres every day. All the primary Cooperative Milk producers' Societies were converted into Anand Pattern Societies with veterinary coverage at the door steps of milk producers. Pondicherry Cooperative Milk Producers Union is funded by the National Dairy Development Board. Necessary steps are also being taken to convert the primaries in Karaikal into Anand pattern. During the Ninth Plan primary milk cooperatives were assisted with furniture subsidy, managerial subsidy, share capital, purchase of dairy equipments, assistance for construction of building.

During the Tenth Plan, it is proposed to start 50 Cooperative Milk Producers Societies including 5 Women coop Milk Producer's Societies. Assistance for working capital, managerial subsidy, purchase of dairy equipments etc for the new societies including women Coop Milk Producer's Societies, is proposed to be given. It is also proposed to assist the Karaikal Cooperative Milk supply Society to expand the existing chilling plant including pasteurisation of milk to handle 10000 litres per day.

## Pattern of Assistance :-

- 1. Working capital assistance will be given in the form of grant to the Primary Milk Producers Societies at the maximum level of Rs.50,000/- per society. Working capital assistance will be given to Milk Producers' Cooperative Union at the maximum of Rs.10.00 lakhs per society.
- 2. Financial assistance in the form of subsidy for the purchase of furniture, collection and testing equipment and managerial subsidy to the Dairy Cooperatives.
- 3. To assist for the construction of building / purchase of site/construction of additional shed, processing and storage facilities including pasteurization and for purchase of machinery to the Dairy Cooperative Union. The assistance will be in the form of 25% Loan and 75% grant
