#### FORESTRY & WILD LIFE

The Forestry and Wildlife sector envisages the schemes for urban afforestation, social forestry in rural areas, planting of tree saplings on banks of rivers, channels, tank bunds, roadsides and coastal areas and wildlife and birds conservation. During the first four years of the Ninth Plan, an area of 273 Ha. has been covered under afforestation in public lands and a total of 17.87 lakh seedlings have been distributed free of cost for afforestation in private lands.

Efforts to curb poaching and illegal trading of scheduled animals and their parts etc. under Wildlife (Protection) Act,1972 and illegal trade and transport of timber and other forest produce under Indian Forest Act, 1927 and rules made there under were taken up. Several cases were registered and prosecuted or compounded with suitable fine. In the interest of administrative convenience and to improve the efficacy of law enforcement, a separate Directorate of Forests and Wildlife is proposed to be created during the Annual Plan 2002-2003. To attend to the activities of the new directorate creation of posts and construction of office buildings are required. During the Tenth Plan, it is proposed to create 125 hectare plantations, distribute ten lakh seedlings for planting in private lands, extend JFM to thirty villages, set up eight check posts and four mobile protection squads, bring twenty forest patches under management plan, conduct ten educational tours, establish three seed orchards, organize thirty training-cumentrepreneurship development programmes for farmers etc. During the year 2002-03, it is proposed to create 25 hectare plantations, distribute two lakh seedlings for planting in private lands, extend JFM to six villages, set up two check posts and one mobile protection squad, bring four forest patches under management plan, conduct two educational tours, establish one seed orchards, organize six training-cum-entrepreneurship development programmes for the farmers.
