LAND REFORMS

The programmes under this sector envisages mainly updating of land records in all the four regions and distribution of patta pass book to the land holders. Imparting survey training to the field staff and the survey and settlement operation is also a part of the scheme.

During the Ninth Plan, Computerisation of Land Records was done in respect of the Land Records of 61 villages comprised in Villianur and Bahour Sub-Taluk. Computerisation of Land Records of Karaikal, Mahe and Yanam Regions have been taken up. Issue of computerised patta/chitta copy to the land owners of Villianur and Bahour Sub-Taluk are being issued. Computerisation of land records of 6 Revenue Villages of Ariankuppam Commune of Pondicherry Taluk have been completed. Pilot Project work for computerisation of FMB of Villianur and Bahour Sub-Taluk will be completed under Centrally Sponsored Scheme. The Town Survey has been started in the towns of Oulgaret Municipality.

During the Tenth Plan, it is proposed to update the scheme of land records in Mahe Region. Computerisation of Land Records of Towns will be taken up. Re-Survey and Settlement scheme will be initiated. A suitable module have been prepared for computerizing the Town survey settlement register. Test Data entry of one Block have been made. After standardization of the software, data entry work will be initiated to expedite computerization of land records. It is also proposed to impart survey training to 125 officials.
