#### **ROAD TRANSPORT**

The Government Automobile Workshop is the centralised service department in the Union Territory of Pondicherry for maintenance of all government vehicles. This Department also supplies fuel and lubricants to government vehicles, engine generators, kitchen equipment in Government Departments as well as quasi Government Agencies and Central Government Departments.

To ensure that all the services rendered by the Transport Department to the public are completed in time bound manner, all the activities are being computerised and adequate man power has to be provided. To promote awareness among public on road safety measures a separate "Road safety cell" is proposed to be set up. Seminars, conduct of road safety weeks, conduct of elocution competition among school children, posters, placards containing road safety slogans are the ways by which awareness on road safety is proposed to be promoted in the minds of public. Setting up of check posts at border areas in Pondicherry and Karaikal regions has been conceived as an important tool to achieve increase in revenue collection and to plug the loophole in tax evasion by vehicle owners of local and other states.

The Government Automobile Workshop set up by the Government of Pondicherry is intended to carryout the major and minor repairs to all Government of Pondicherry vehicles. It supplies POL to all Government vehicles, Central Govt. Vehicles, vehicles belonging to Quasi Govt. Organizations, fuels to Generators, Central Kitchen etc. There is a full-fledged service station meant for servicing all Government of Pondicherry Vehicles.
