TOURISM

Pondicherry has a rich French Cultural heritage, having been the capital of the French Colonies in India since the 17th Century. With a coast line of 32 Kms, well planned French Bouleward town, palm fringed beaches, resorts, backwaters, water sports centre, fishing villages, harbour, the pier, Aurobindo Ashram, Auroville and other attractions Pondicherry is the ideal place for spending holidays with family. The tourism potential of Pondicherry is not fully tapped. The Government of Pondicherry with the help of the Government of India has jointly made efforts to boost the tourism activities in Pondicherry.

A Media Plan has been prepared to promote tourism activities such as advertisement in various newspapers/magazines, erection of hoardings, ECR campaign, F.M. Radio, C.D. and participation in various Travel/Tourism Marts in India and abroad. Beautification of Beach and park at Pondicherry will be taken up. Development of water sports in all the four regions, ecotourism in Yanam, renovation of forts in Mahe and establishment of an Art & Craft village at Pondicherry are some of the other important programmes. On the infrastructural side, construction of additional block at Govt. tourist home, Yanam, Shore cottages at Karaikal Beach Resort. Expansion of Jetty at Arasalar River Karaikal and acquisition of land and construction of tourist home at Mahe will be undertaken. Share capital assistance will be provided to tourism and transport development corporation and grant-in-aid will be released to hotel management institute. The department will organize cultural festivals like, food festival, shopping festival, French festical, yoga festival, summer festival and dance festival at Pondicherry. Under heritage tourism it is proposed to take up flood lighting and preservation of heritage buildings. A heritage walk and a video film on heritage tourism will be taken up.
