#### **EDUCATION**

Education plays a vital role in the Economic, Social and Cultural Development of a country. Besides, moulding characters and values of the citizens, the overall growth of the country depends entirely on Educational growth. Hence, in any development plan education is given top priority among all social activities. In so far as the Union Territory of Pondicherry is concerned Education has been placed in a better position due to top priority given by this Administration.

In the Tenth Plan the national goals put forth by Planning Commission in respect of Education Sector are:

- i) Universal access to Primary Education by 2007 and
- ii) Increase in literacy rates to 72% by 2007 and 80% by 2012.

As per the 2001 census figure the literacy rate in the Union Territory of Pondicherry is 81.49 as against the National average of65.38 and this Union Territory has been placed under category-IV which includes States and Union Territories having literacy rate 75% and above. The Union Territory of Pondicherry is in the 7<sup>th</sup> place in the ranking of literacy rate among all States/Union Territories. The task before this Union Territory is to ensure universal access to Primary Education and to achieve 90% literacy rate by the end of Tenth Plan and 100% literacy rate by 2012. In order to ensure universal access to Primary Education, Compulsory Education Bill has been passed in the winter session 2003 of the Legislative Assembly and forwarded to Govt. of India for obtaining President's assent.

The Gross Enrolment ratio at Primary and Upper Primary Level is as follows:

The aforesaid Gross Enrolment Ratio reflects that this Union Territory is a "School Loving Territory". Therefore are totally 652 Education Institutions both Government and Private in this Union Territory ranging from Primary to Higher Secondary level. Of this, 424 are under State Government, 6 under Central Government and 222 under Private Management. Out of 222 Private schools, 36 schools received grant-in-aid from Government at the rate of 95% as Maintenance Grant. Almost all the habitations in this Union Territory are provided with Primary School facility within 1 km. Distance.

Further, the Teacher Pupil Ratio in the Union Territory is in a comfortable position as can be seen from the following table:

In order to improve enrolment, ensure retention and reduce drop out further various welfare schemes such as Free supply of textbooks, stationeries, chappals and uniforms are being implemented. Besides, Mid-day Meals Schemes is also implemented for the poor students. Above all, a novel scheme called "Shri Rajiv Gandhi Breakfast Schemes" is implemented since 2002-03 for the first time in the entire country. Moreover, various kinds of scholarships both under State / CSS. Schemes are implemented.

Free Distribution of Dictionaries to 44,509 students studying in VIII to XII Standard of Government/Government Aided Schools in Pondicherry, Karaikal, Mahe and Yanam. 81,991 Poor students studying in Standard I to VII in Government schools were supplied with Hawai Chappals at free cost. Free Distribution of Uniforms to 9,000 poor students studying in XI & XII of Govt. Higher Secondary Schools in Pondicherry, Karaikal, Mahe and Yanam. A novel scheme 'Community Service Scheme' has been launched in 50 High Schools covering 2,500 students. Pondicherry is the first Union Territory to introduce this new programme. The Department of Education was bifurcated into two separate Directorate viz.i) Directorate of School Education and ii) Directorate of Collegiate & Technical Education vide G.O.Ms.No.89 dated 111/07/2003 of Chief Secretariat. Balwadies hitherto functioning under the Department of Women and Child Development have been taken over by Directorate of School Education for running Pre-Primary for children aged 3 years and above vide G.O.Ms.No.111 dated 22/09/2003 of Chief Secretariat(Education). To impart training in Computer literacy level of school education of VI Std. and above. Formation of Village Education Committee at Rural schools and School level Committee at Urban school to implement /monitor SSA.scheme. Opening of new building in respect of GPS.Pudupalayam (T.V.Nagar), GPS, .Solainagar, Jeevarathinam GGMS., Veerampattinam, GMS., Nellithope, GHS., Katterikuppam, GPS, Thattanchavady (V) were inaugurated. Conversion of 100 thatched shed class room into pucca building. State Level Science Exhibition will be conducted in Yanam region besides Regional level Science Exhibition in all regions.

Under collegiate education 17 Under Graduate courses and 3 Post Graduate courses were started in different colleges. New courses namely, corporate secretaryship, business administration, mass communication, micro biology will be introduced in the UG level, computer application, bio technology and electronics in post graduate level will be started. M.Phil courses in Commerce, Maths, History, English and French were started in the P.G. Centre. Under technical education new courses in business administration and environmental engineering will be started. A center for advanced studies in disaster management and energy technology will be started in Engineering college. New courses in M.Tech. (Electrical & Electonics ) was started with an intake of 82 students and M.C.A. with an intake of 10 students.PIPMATE will be assisted for maintaining four polytechnics and intake capacity in women's polytechnic will be increased.

Distribution of various awards namely, Nehru Children's literary award, Tholgappier Award, Kamban Pugazh Literary Award and celebration of vizhas namely Tamil Esai vizha, Puduvai Sivam vizha, Vanidasan vizha, Tamil Oli vizha are some of the programmes implemented by Art and Culture Directorate. Grants-in-aid will released to Pondicherry Institute of Linguistics and Culture and Bharathi Palkalaikoodam. Financial assistance will be provided to indigent tamil scholars and artists. Under the improvement to Pondicherry Archives scheme, a micro film reader will be setup for preservation of fragile and rare records. With the help of regional records survey committee collection of records will be undertaken. Improvements to Ambedkar Manimandapam and setting up of Archaeological museum at Karaikal and Mahe and inter-state of cultural troups are some of the other important programmes.

The weaker section of the society still find it difficult to send their children to schools as they are unable to cope up with resulting burden of expenditure. As an incentive to poor students for attracting them to schools at the elementary level, to ensure their retention in the age group 6-14 years and to increase enrolment; text books, stationeries, uniforms and footwear will be supplied to poor children studying in I-X Stds., subject to the annual parental income of Rs.24,000/- per annum.

# 3.(a) Actual Physical Achievement 2002-03:

Free supply of uniforms extended to poor students studying upto X standards in Govt. and Govt. aided schools. 1,06,300 students were provided with free uniforms, 87,800 poor students were provided with footwears, 77,700 poor students were be provided with exercise note books and 106300 students were provided with text books/stationery.

Free supply of uniforms will be extended upto XII std. in Govt. and Govt. aided schools. 1,11,600 poor students will be benefited under free supplies of text books, stationery and 1,11,600 students under free supply of uniforms. 92,200 poor students will be benefited under free supply of footwear. 81,600 poor students will be benefited under exercise note books and 48,800 students will be provided with stationery. Purchase of dictionaries (English – Tamil in Pondicherry, Karaikal region, English – Malayalam in Mahe region and English – Telugu in Yanam region) for distribution to students in VIII std. to XII std. in Govt./Govt.Aided Schools.
