HEALTH

The health care system comprises of activities for health protection, promotion and rehabilitation. The health care approach has been primarily to ensure availability, accessibility and acceptability for the population, quality in health care by monitoring & effective supervision and coordination of health related sectors.

During 2004-05, it is envisaged to provide the required drugs, surgical materials, equipments for the General Hospitals, Maternity Hospitals, ESI Hospital, Govt. Hospital for Chest Diseases and Health Centres. To improve the functions of the Departments of Blood Bank, Casuality, Anaesthesia, General Medicine, Cardiology, Paediatric, Nephrology, Neurology, General Surgery, Ophthalmology, Orthopaedics etc. in GH, Pondicherry by providing modern latest equipments. It is propose to establish Drug De-addiction Centre and to increase the bed strength in chest diseases from 25 to 50 in GH, Karaikal. The existing bed strength is proposed to be increased from 50 to 80 and specialty services in Ortho to be started in GH, Yanam. It is propose to strengthen the New Born Nursery, Pathology and Bio-chemistry, Obstetrics & Gynaecology Departments. It is propose to set up a two bedded intensive care unit in MH, Pondicherry.

Under blindness control programme, it is propose to procure latest equipment like auto perimeter, laser equipment, to conduct the survey of blind persons in the urban areas. Grant-in-aid will be release to Dental College and Mother Teresa Institute of Health Sciences. Under leprosy control programme, it is propose to achieve the goal of elimination of Leprosy by reducing the prevalence rate to less than 1 per 10,000 population in the years to come. Under filaria control programme, anti Larval activities, detection cum treatment of night blood survey, surveillance activities for easy diagnosis of case and prompt treatment and purchase of fogging machines and sprayers etc.

Acquisition of land / construction of buildings for various administrative Offices such as Directorate / Dy. Directors / Asst. Directors. Adopting of Central Purchase Committee system towards purchase of medicines, surgical items, lab items, radiological items and for machinery & equipments and taking steps to provide qualitative management in the field of health services. To provide comprehensive service to the disabled persons by way of fitting of artificial limb and orthopaedic appliances and propose to start hydrotherapy and magnetotherapy. Purchase of equipments for the effective use and smooth functioning of the Public Health Lab and computerisation of data in the Food & Drugs Administration.

Under ISM, it is proposed to construct a 50 bedded hospital for ISM & H, expansion of Panchakarma special therapies, increasing the number of Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani and Homeopathy dispensaries, opening of 10 bedded Ayurveda hospital at Mahe. It is proposed to start one Naturopathy and yoga unit in Pondicherry region. The newly formed Directorate of ISM & H will be strengthened with purchase of equipments, vehicles and creation of posts.
