LABOUR & LABOUR WELFARE

During 2004-05, It is proposed to set up a Rural Labour Welfare Centre at Palloor, Mahe, provide Grant-in-aid to NGOs / Voluntary Organizations so as to enable them to rehabilitate the child labour and to run special schools for them. The laboratory of the Inspectorate of Factories will be equipeed with modern equipments in order to assess / scrutinize the safe environment for labourers in the Industries / Factories. An Overseas Man power Export Cell will be set up to have a centralized source of Technical and Professional manpower available in the U.T. and to explore the scope and promote for their opportunities of employment in foreign countries. Networking of computers in the Labour Department (Labour Net) is proposed during 2004-05. Apart from these programmes, introduction of additional trades / units in the existing seven Govt. I.T.I.s, setting up of Fisherman Training Centre with modern fishing and mechanic marine engine courses, in the Govt. I.T.I. (Men), Pondicherry, expansion of Industrial Training Park and Vocational Training Centre for Physically challenged persons will be taken up.

In order to ensure harmonious relationship between the labourers and managements a "Good Industrial Relation Award" has been Instituted. During the year 2004-05, It is expected to dispose off 240 Conciliation cases and four Seminars on Industrial Harmony are to be conducted. Grant-in-aid will be provided to the Pondicherry Unorganised Labourers' Welfare Society and The Pondicherry Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board for their activities. To create awareness among the labourers on safety measures Safety Seminars and Safety Day/Week will be celebrated and the managements are encouraged by giving "Industrial Safety Award" to provide safe environment to the labourers in the Industrial Units. Every year, it is aimed to medically examine 1800 workers and to give Safety Training to over 3600 workers. Every year Career Guidance seminars are conducted at various places for tenth and twelfth standard students so as to make them aware of the various job oriented courses offered in various institutions in the U.T. of Pondicherry and in the country and to choose the course of suitable to them. At present 1,61,000 candidates are in live register of the Employment Exchanges of Pondicherry.

The Pondicherry Building and Other Construction Workers' Welfare Board was constituted since January, 2003, to extend welfare measures, to the Building and Other Construction Workers of 37 categories, initially with the following benefits/grants:

a) Maternity Benefit - Rs.1,000/b) Funeral Assistance - Rs.1,000/c) Death benefit - Rs.15,000/d) Accident benefit - Rs.50,000/-

Covering 1,000 workers under the scheme. So far 571 have been enrolled this year alone and all have been covered under the "Janashree Bima Yojana" Life Insurance.
