#### OTHER ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES

#### FIRE SERVICE

Under modernization programme it is proposed to purchase of delivery hoses, additional equipments for wireless communication system, procurement of two large fire engines and construction of two fire stations. Moreover, it is proposed to provide feeder units to existing fire station at Kalapet, Villianur and Thirukanur and to fill up 54 number of technical posts.

#### **DAT**

During Annual Plan 2004-05, it is proposed to implement the following new components of the spill over scheme viz. establishment of Accounts currents section in the Directorate and Cash Monitoring and expenditure cell in finance department in order to enable an effective control over expenditure and monitoring the flow of cash. As a part of e-governance, it is proposed to purchase computers and software towards computerizing remaining fields of activities.

#### **COMMERCIAL TAXES**

As per the Government of India policy decision the existing system of general sales tax is likely to be replaced by VAT shortly. All preparatory works for implementation of the VAT including drafting of VAT Law / Rules, training of officers and interaction meeting with the mercantile community are being conducted. Under this system, tax is to be levied in all the stages of sale but on the value addition only. This would increase the number of dealers 3 times of existing level and hence the work load will increase considerably. Under proposed VAT system, auditing in the dealers premises is contemplated and the officers are required to visit the shops periodically for which additional vehicles are required. Computerisation play a very vital role in cross verification in the VAT system and therefore the existing computerisation is to be upgraded. Development of VAT software already finalized. In order to strengthen the department and provide additional manpower towards the implementation of VAT, it is proposed to create 26 posts in the Annual Plan 2004-05.

#### **POLICE**

Communication system in Police Department is being strengthened by implementing POLNET project with modern equipments and e-governance system by computerizing all the Police Stations, Crime Records Branch and various units. During the Annual Plan 2004-05, it is proposed that. purchase of arms and ammunitions, surveillance equipments, and coastal security equipments.

#### **REVENUE**

During the Annual Plan 2004-05 the entire registration department is proposed to modernised by providing office equipments, furniture, EPBAX system replacement two wheelers, computers and its accessories, hosting of web site, etc. and to mitigate, prevent and pro-active management of any kinds of natural and manmade disaster and to aid proper rescue operation, the Revenue Department has proposed to strengthen the capacities and to equip with proper infrastructure with latest technology in order to meet at any eventuality.

# **HINDU RELIGIOUS INSTITUTIONS**

Desilting the tanks, ponds, wells located in various temples. Release of financial assistance to temples located in SC colonies and economically weaker section areas for performing renovations and also to conduct "Oru Gala Pooja" and to meet the current consumption charges are the programmes implemented by this department.

Many of the temples located in low-income group category are finding it difficult to get daily poojas as per the Agama principles. To overcome this difficulty and to perform at least one time pooja as per the Agama/Vedic rules, it is proposed to extend financial assistance at the rate of Rs.5,000/- per annum per temple, under "ORU GALA POOJA SCHEME".

In the Union Territory of Pondicherry, tanks, ponds, wells of certain temples hailing under the category "low/middle income groups" require DESILTING AND OTHER IMPROVEMENT WORKS so as to cater to the needs of the pilgrims/worshipers visiting the temples.

As many of the temples are not financially sound enough even to meet out the expenditure relating to Current Consumption Charges, it is proposed to release financial assistance at the rate of Rs.500/- per annum to such temples under "FREE POWER SUPPLY SCHEME".
