#### **FISHERIES**

The Union Territory of Pondicherry comprises of four maritime regions viz., Pondicherry, Karaikal, Mahe and Yanam with a coastal line of 45 kms with 675 sq.kms of inshore waters. Various development oriented plan and welfare schemes are implemented with an objective to augment marine, inland and Brackish water fishery production and socio-economic development of fishermen community.

Development of freshwater aquaculture is encouraged in all the derelicted inland water bodies. Input Subsidy is proposed to be enhanced from Rs.3000 to Rs.5000 besides grant of subsidy towards supply of aquarium tanks. Prawn culture will be taken up in brackishwater resources as per the guidelines of Aquaculture authority of India besides formation of Aquaculture Society with the assistance of World Bank which will concentrate on Research and Development of Mussel Culture, Lobster/Crab fattening and Sea ranching etc. It is also proposed to offer training and employment opportunities among fishermen and fisherwomen. Modernisation of country crafts is gaining momentum and it is proposed to assist the fishermen for the procurement of FRP catamaran, FRP Vallam and Marine Plywood canoes. envisaged to grant 40% subsidy to fishermen for the construction of mechanized boat ranging from 32' to 65' in length availing loans from banks besides grant of subsidy towards insurance of boats, supply of lifebuoys, insulated ice box, distress signal torch etc. It is proposed to increase the fish production from 44,500 MT to 57,000 MT by the end of tenth plan. It is also proposed to construct fishing harbours at Karaikal, Mahe and Yanam. The newly established Fishing Harbour Management Society will look after the maintenance and management of fishing harbour projects at Pondicherry and at other regions. It is proposed to provide information KIOSK in the aquarium and office complex. It is proposed to construct iceplant and cold storage / processing units at the fishing harbour sites encouraging private sector / co-operative Societies, formation of fisherwomen co-operative societies and extending financial assistance. Implementation of integrated marine fishery development project availing loan from the National Co-operative Development Corporation through Pondicherry State Fishermen Co-operative Federation. Implementation of various schemes for the welfare of fishermen during natural calamities, fishing ban period, old age insurance coverage etc. Various welfare schemes including pension to fishermen will be implemented through Pondicherry fishermen welfare and Distress relief society. Cash awards will be granted to meritorious students belonging to fishermen community. Mechanised fishing boats will be colour coded. Hosting of website is proposed.

Grant of 50% subsidy limited to a maximum of Rs.30,000/- to the Apex/Central Societies for the purchase of a computer comprising of monitor and keyboard, CPU, UPS and printer to improve the efficiency of the accounting and other related works. The subsidy will be claimed after procurement and submission of bills.

#### 7. Subsidy for retail fish sales KIOSK

50% subsidy to a maximum of Rs.50,000/- per unit for setting up of new modern hygienic retail fish sales KIOSK under Co-operative sector.

#### 8. Subsidy to run Canteen at Fishing Harbour

Rs.25,000/- is proposed as annual lump sum grant to be released to the Fisherwomen Co-operative Society which runs a canteen at Pondicherry fishing harbour complex, Pondicherry to meet the establishment changes.

9. Grant-in-aid to Pondicherry State Fishermen Co-operative Federation for NCDC Scheme.

It is proposed to release grant-in-aid to Pondicherry State Fishermen Co-operative Federation, Pondicherry to meet establishment and contingent charges for implementing N.C.D.C programmes subject to a maximum of Rs.3.00 lakhs per year as decided by Government.

## 2. Objective of the Scheme

The objective of the scheme is to extend financial assistance to fishermen during lean months. To inculcate saving habit, a sum of Rs.50/- will be collected per month per member from inland fishermen who are Members of Fishermen Co-Operative Societies for a period of 8 months in a year. A total amount of Rs.400/- thus collected will be matched by double matching grant by State Government. The total sum of Rs.1200/- will be disbursed during the 4 lean months to each Fishermen/Fisherwomen Member equally at the rate of Rs.300/- per month. To provide state grant of Rs.200/- per each marine fishermen/member to implement centrally sponsored savings-cum-relief scheme under which a sum of Rs.50/- will be collected per month from marine fishermen who are members of Fishermen Co-Operative Societies for a period of 8 months in a year. A total amount of Rs.400/- thus collected will be matched upto Rs.200/- by the State and Rs.600/- by the Government of India in the existing pattern. The total sum of Rs.1200/- will be disbursed during the four lean months equally at the rate of Rs.300/- per month. To provide relief in the form of food, cloth, rice and other essential commodities to the fishermen community during natural calamities like cyclone, flood, fire, drought, etc. To provide cash assistance @ Rs.300/- and 90 Kgs of free rice to each of fishermen family during the period of ban on fishing. To provide Government share of Insurance premium for covering fisherwomen under Janashree Bima yojana scheme. To provide Grant-in-aid to Pondicherry Fishermen Welfare and Distress Relief Society to implement welfare programmes such as Old age pension. Scholarship to fishermen students for H.Sc. and diploma studies, incentive for adopting small family norms, encouraging remarriage of widows, Assistance to fisherwomen for

pre and post natal period, marriage assistance to one daughter in a family, funeral assistance and supply of free spectacles etc., The monitory loss sustained by fishermen due to loss of crafts and tackles while fishing will be granted with assistance through the Distress relief Soceity. The families of the fishermen who are missed in the sea while fishing will be granted with assistance through this society if they are not covered under insurance scheme. To grant cash awards to meritorious students belonging to fishermen community who score first, second and third ranks in Matric or equivalent / SSLC/HSC/French Brevae classes.
