ROAD TRANSPORT

The Government Automobile Workshop is the centralised service department in the Union Territory of Pondicherry for maintenance of all government vehicles. This Department also supplies fuel and lubricants to government vehicles, engine generators, kitchen equipment in Government Departments as well as quasi Government Agencies and Central Government Departments.

The objective of the Transport Department is to provide services to the public in a time bound manner for which the activities of the department are being computerised. In order to promote awareness among the public on road safety measures a road safety cell is proposed to be setup and seminars, celebration of road safety weeks, conduct of competitions among school children, posters, placards on road safety slogans are also conducted. Setting up of check-posts in the border areas to enhance the revenue collection and to plug loop holes in tax evasion in the other programme proposed in the Annual Plan 2005-06.
