COMPUTERISATION

A separate Directorate of Information Technology has started functioning in the administration from the Annual Plan 2003-04. To implement the e-governance, 16 selected departments were studied and a comprehensive Master Plan for implementation of e-Governance and Establishment of IT Back bone was prepared. Action is being taken for the implementation of the six initiatives viz. Primary Data Center, State Wide Area network, email Infrastructure, two core applications on Accounts, Finance, Purchase and Inventory & Payroll and Human Resources Management System and One Department applications School Administration and Management System. Request for Proposals(RFP) for the six initiatives has been floated. It is proposed to conduct seminars and workshops on e-Governance. It is proposed to establish Citizen Interactions Center for Integrated Citizen services, which will enable the common man to pay all the utility bills like electricity, water, telephone and get birth/death certificates, etc. at one counter.
