# EDUCATION

## **School Education**

Education plays a vital role in the Economic, Social and Cultural Development of a country. Besides, moulding characters and values of the citizens, the overall growth of the country depends entirely on educational growth. Hence, in any development plan education is given top priority among all social activities. It has also been decided by the Government that nobody is denied education because he or she is poor, hence, various welfare schemes have been implemented to increase enrolment, ensure retention and reduce drop out etc. It is also proposed to create proper infrastructural facilities in schools and to strengthen NCC, NSS, physical development, sports and cultural development of all students.

As per the Government of India's guidelines, "the Sarva Siksha Abhiyan, Union Territory of Pondicherry Mission Authority" came into existence in 2002. The main objective of the Sarva Siksha Abhiyan is

- 1. All children in the age group 6-14 years in formal schools, Education Guarantee Centers, Alternative Schools or 'Back to School Camps' by 2003
- 2. All children complete five years of primary schooling by 2007
- 3. All children complete eight years of elementary schooling by 2010
- 4. Focus on elementary education of satisfactory quality with emphasis on education for life
- 5. Bridge all gender and social category gaps at primary stage by 2007 and at elementary stage by 2010
- 6. Universal retention by 2010

The programme envisaged during the Annual Plan 2005-06 is to start diploma course in Pre-Primary teacher training in DIET. 100 students will be enrolled under Sarva Siksha Abhiyan Scheme. It is proposed to universalize computer education at upper-primary and secondary levels, Organisation of 'students fair' for selling the articles produced by the girl and SC children under 'Vocational Skill Development' programme, Production of content based interactive CDs in regional languages, Concentration on pre-school and primary level education to avoid drop outs at all levels, Strengthening and extension of 'Counseling Services' for girls at secondary level, Devising necessary interventions to achieve 'Universalisation of Secondary Education' by 2012, Upgradation of primary schools, middle schools and high schools into next higher standard, Completion of the task of construction of classrooms in schools where thatched sheds have been removed, To ensure availability of infrastructural facilities like water supply and sanitation in all schools, Provision of benches, desks and other furniture to the required schools.

Starting of more self employment oriented vocational courses, Strengthening of teaching ability of teachers by imparting training through STC, Identification of weaker students and giving special coaching to create interest in study and ensure retention, Encouragement to the teachers by awarding mementoes and star status to those who produced cent percent result during past 5 years continuously, Starting of own website and introduction of E-Governance in Directorate of School Education to ensure transparency in administration and enable the public to have access to information on education, Starting of construction of sports complex at Karaikal, Mahe and Yanam, Provision of playground facilities in schools where site is readily available and in respect of other to identify required land for acquisition, To set up mini stadium in each commune, Increase the enrolment of volunteers under NSS by 1000, Participation in National Jamborees, To construct auditorium/conference hall in the vacant site available in Perunthalaivar Kamarajar Centenary Educational Complex at Anna Nagar.

## **Collegiate & Technical Education**

The Directorate of Collegiate & Technical Education was bifurcated from the rest while Directorate of Education to set up a separate establishment for dealing with the matters pertains to the Higher Education. The Government of Pondicherry wants to impart quality higher education and have established various colleges in the Government sector and also under various Societies. Apart from this private institutions to initiate in the field of higher education, the Government is providing No Objection Certificate for Private Management to start Arts & Science Colleges and Professional Colleges.

There are Six Government Arts & Science Colleges in the U.T. of Pondicherry. Kanchi Mamunivar Centre for Post Graduate Studies is exclusively for conducting of PG courses. There are three Arts & Science Colleges under the Union Territory of Pondicherry Arts, Science & Technology Colleges Society. These colleges are mainly promoted to offer job oriented courses like B.Sc.(Bio-Technology), B.Sc.(Computer Science), B.Sc (Statistics) and B.A.,(Foreign Trade) and B.Sc.(Microbiology) are offered in Indira Gandhi College of Arts & Science. A Women's college will be started in the academic year 2005-06 at Villianur to cater the needs of the rural population.

As far as Professional Colleges are concerned, Pondicherry Engineering College which offers B.Tech., B.D.S., B.V.Sc. & A.H., B.Sc.(Agri), B.Pharm, B.Sc.(Nursing), B.P.T., B.Sc.(MLT) and M.B.B.S. degree courses under Pondicherry Quota. In the Private sector, Government has given NOC to start Four Engineering Colleges.

To promote Post Matric Technical Education, the Government has established a Pondicherry Institute of Post Matric Education Society which runs Four Polytechnic Colleges apart from Government Polytechnic viz. Motilal Nehru Government Polytechnic located at Lawspet.

The main function of this Directorate is to deal with the service matters of the Lecturers, their career progression and providing infrastructure facilities to the colleges. The academic part of the college is comes under the purview of the Pondicherry University.

## Law

During 2005-06, it is proposed to commence 3 year full time LLB course for degree holders, Post Graduate courses (LLM) and Post Graduate Diploma courses in Law. It is also proposed to strengthen the law colleges by purchasing library books, journals, furnitures and conducting seminars.

## Art & Culture

The Union Territory of Pondicherry, the erstwhile French colony has many legacies of art & culture with a rich heritage. This Department has been envisaged in order to develop the arts, literature, political legacies and remembrance of great poets. One of the prime functions is to establish new libraries, reading rooms besides developing the old libraries for encouraging the literary and reading habits among the general public and also providing facilities for research scholars & students. In order to encourage the dying folk arts and to develop them, various vizhas are being conducted such as Music, Dance, Folk, Painting camps etc. This includes the

mega festival Fete de Pondichery where, artists from various states are being invited for participation and providing colourful traditional dances of various states. To enlighten the patriotism and history of Pondicherry, various memorial museums have been established in the name of Bharathiar, Bharathidasan and Dr. Ambedkar for the future generation.

To encourage the literary works, research works etc. awards have been instituted in the name of Tamizh Mamani, Puduvai Kalai Mamani, Kamban Pugazh Literary Award, Nehru Childrens' Literary Award, Tholkappier Award and also 'llaignar Mamani' etc. These awards consist of cash prize and gold coins. Eminent and outstanding artists in the field of literature, music, dance, drama and painting are also honoured with such awards.

The remains of Aricamedu and the erstwhile French regime, antiques are being preserved in the Pondicherry Museum.Tamil Development Wing has been functioning to develop the Tamil language for the implementation of Official Language Act in the Union Territory of Pondicherry.Linguistic studies, ethnographic studies are being taught for the students in the Pondicherry Institute of Linguistic and Culture which is an apex society of Art & culture. Annual grant is also being released.

An autonomous body in the name of "Bharathiar Palkalaikoodam" has been established in order to provide, graduate studies in the field of music, dance, sculpture etc. Annual grant is also being released.. Grant-in-aid is being provided to PILC. Grant will be given to M/s. INTACH, Pondicherry Municipality, Pondicherry University and Dravidian University.

In general, this department is functioning as a ladder for the general public to know about the history, legacy and life styles of great poets and patriots besides encouraging artists in various fields and also preserving the antiques of Pondicherry. Construction of Dr. Ambedkar Manimandapam, Bharathiar Manimandapam, Renovation of old Museum and Construction / improvements to libraries will be made.

## 2. Objective of the Scheme

To develop correct habits among children in the age group of 3½ - 5 years by offering them opportunities for healthy recreation and institutional care. With the objective of giving a proper recognition to early childhood education which is the first step in the total educational continuum, it is proposed to introduce LKG in 253 Government Primary schools and subsequently UKG during the Tenth Five Year plan. This includes 197 Balawadies to be transferred to Education Deptt. from Social Welfare Department, 38 Govt. pre-primary schools and opening of 18 new pre-primary schools.

## 3.(a) Actual physical Achievement 2003-04 :

i. LKG classes were started in 160 pre-primary schools.

## (b) Anticipated Physical Achievement 2004-05 :

- i. LKG classes will be started in the remaining schools and U.K.G classes will be started wherever LKG classes already started.
- ii. Creation of teachers/Part-time helpers posts on consolidated pay.
- iii. Purchase of furniture, toys, play materials, equipments, baby chairs etc.

The weaker section of the society still find it difficult to send their children to schools as they are unable to cope up with resulting burden of expenditure. As an incentive to poor students for attracting them to schools at the elementary level, to ensure their retention in the age group 6-14 years and to increase enrolment; text books, stationeries, uniforms and footwear will be supplied to poor children studying in I-X Stds., subject to the annual parental income of Rs.24,000/- per annum.

# 3.(a) Actual physical Achievement 2003-04 :

Free supply of uniforms was extended up to XII std. in Govt. and Govt. aided schools. 1,06,300 poor students was benefited under free supplies of text books , stationery and 1,15,850 students under free supply of uniforms. 1,08,000 poor students was benefited under free supply of footwear. 77,700 poor students was benefited under exercise note books and 48,800 students was provided with stationery. Dictionaries were distributed to 19,080 students studying in std. VIII std. to XII Std.
