

HEALTH

The Health Care System comprises of activities for health protection, promotion and rehabilitation. The health care approach has been primarily to ensure availability, accessibility and acceptability for the population, quality in health care by monitoring & effective supervision and coordination of health related sectors.

Under blindness control programme, it is proposed to procure latest equipment like auto perimeter, laser equipment, to conduct the survey of blind persons in the urban areas. Grant-in-aid will be release to Dental College and Mother Teresa Institute of Health Sciences. Under leprosy control programme, the goal of elimination of Leprosy by reducing the prevalence rate to less than 1 per 10,000 populations has been achieved and the tempo has to be sustained the years to come. Under Filaria control programme, anti Larval activities, detection cum treatment of night blood survey, surveillance activities for easy diagnosis of case and prompt treatment and purchase of fogging machines and sprayers etc have been proposed.

It is planned for acquisition of land / construction of buildings for various administrative Offices such as Directorate / Dy. Directors / Asst. Directors. To adopt of Central Purchase Committee system towards purchase of medicines, surgical items, lab items, and radiological items and for machinery & equipments and taking steps to provide qualitative management in the field of health services. To provide comprehensive service to the disabled persons by way of fitting of artificial limb and orthopedic appliances and propose to start hydrotherapy and magneto therapy. It is also planned for purchase of equipments for the effective use and smooth functioning of the Public Health Lab and computerization of data in the Food & Drugs Administration.

During the year 2005-06, it is proposed to construct a 700-bedded women and children hospital at Pondicherry. To improve the health care system, it is proposed to set up one Cardiac Cathlab at Cardiology Department of GH, Pondicherry for carrying out the Coronary Angiographies and Angioplasty Surgery. It is also proposed for opening of Cardiac care facility in outlying regions by providing equipments, strengthening of Urology Department at GH, Pondicherry, setting up of Plastic Re-constructive Surgery at GH., Pondicherry, establishment of Tele-Consultation facilities between GH, Pondicherry, Karaikal, Mahe and Yanam, Measles, Mums, Rubella (MMR) vaccine will be given to all children in the age group of 1 to 2 years in the U.T. of Pondicherry, Administration of Anti-Rabies vaccine at all PHCs/CHCs and Insulin Injection to the diabetic patients, establishment of infertility clinic at MH, Pondicherry, Starting up of Senior Residency system at GH and MH, Pondicherry to ensure the availability of Specialist Doctors round the clock, Upgradation of GH and MH, Pondicherry as Post-Graduate Institution, the scheme "issue of dresses, towels and soaps to new born female babies" will be extended to all babies irrespective of gender, Critical Care Unit and modernized operation theatre will be established GH Mahe.

A separate Department of Indian Systems of Medicine & Homoeopathy was established to facilitate the development of Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani, Naturopathy & Yoga and Homoeopathy Systems of Medicine. The ISM&H offers uninterrupted health care facility to the people and serving as alternative to Allopathy with better therapeutic goals & peoples satisfaction. Further, expanded service with special therapies like Panchakarma Special Therapies of Ayurveda are to be provided in all the four regions of Union Territory of Pondicherry, the 10 Bedded Government Ayurveda Hospital at Mahe was recently started and it is to be expanded with infrastructure development & facilities.

Indian systems of Medicine & Homoeopathy require special attention & support, to facilitate the development of systems & services to the public, so that the very objectives of the Government of Pondicherry are fulfilled.
