DAIRY DEVELOPMENT

The main objectives of the Dairy Development Programme are to obtain Remunerative milk marketing and development of milch cattle to uplift the socio-economic conditions of the milk producers, to maintain an effective system of the milk and milk products at reasonable price for the consumers and to provide subsidiary occupation to farmers to supplement their income and improve their standard of living.

During the Annual Plan 2005–06 it is proposed to assist the Pondicherry Cooperative Milk Producers' Union for setting up of two chilling centres. It is also proposed to grant share capital assistance to the extent of Rs.50.00 lakhs to strengthen the working capital of the Union. It is proposed to establish two mini dairy chilling plant in rural areas of Pondicherry region.
