WELFARE OF BACKWARD CLASSES

The Adi-dravidar Welfare Department is implementing various innovative schemes for the welfare of SC community under the following two categories.

- 1. Scheme for educational improvements, training self employment to the Scheduled Caste population.
- 2. Scheme for social and economic development of scheduled caste population.

During the Annual Plan 2005-06, it is proposed to start three more hostels. 8,000 SC girl students will be benefited under the scheme of opportunity cost to the parents of SC students. 1,600 SC students will be covered under the award of post-matric scholarship. 1,45,000 SC people will be benefited by supply of clothing items, 100 houseless persons will be allotted free house site pattas. Under the financial assistance to the brides and pregnant lactating women 900 SC would be benefited and 2,000 SC students will be covered under pre-matric scholarship. 900 beneficiaries will be benefited under the Mahatma Gandhi Memorial award for clean house.

As per the instructions of the Government of India, a reservation of 33% has been adopted for education as well as employment opportunities for OBCs in this Union territory.

As part of welfare schemes for the BCs under the education development, 6 Hostels have been opened for BCs students, one for Girls at Pondicherry region, 2 for Boys at Pondicherry region, one Boys Hostel and one girls Hostel at Karaikal region and another one at Yanam where they are given free boarding and lodging to provide a conducive atmosphere for furtherance of their study.

It is proposed to open four hostels, three at Pondicherry region and one at Yanam region in the current financial year. Further an equity share capital is also proposed to be paid to the National Backward Class Finance and Development Corporation and National Minorities Finance and Development Corporation, New Delhi. The Pondicherry Backward Classes and Minorities Development Corporation is functioning in Pondicherry for implementing various welfare measures to the Backward Class people and Minorities and grant in aid is released for the same.

During 2005-06 it is proposed to distribute tools and implements to washerman, Barbers, Nathaswaram and Thavil artisans. The Scheme "Free distribution of cycles to the 9th Standard students of below poverty line families" is renamed as "Free supply of Bi-cycles to all 9th Std. students without income criteria".
