ROAD TRANSPORT

Government Automobile Workshop, Pondicherry which is a Centralized Service Depot set up in the Union Territory of Pondicherry to look after the upkeep and maintenance of all departmental vehicles. Repairs, both major and minor are being carried out in the Workshop. Besides POL products like fuel, lubricants etc. belonging to supplied to all vehicles, agriculture machineries, equipments etc., belonging to Government and quasi Government agencies. A similar mini-workshop, fuelling station and a service station is also functioning in the outlying Karaikal region to cater to repairs, maintenance & services of Government vehicles. A Motor Vehicle Driving Training Institute is functioning in Pondicherry and training to unemployed youths is imparted in driving Light Motor Vehicles and Heavy motor Vehicles. One Emission Under Control Test Station each at Government Automobile Workshop, Pondicherry & Government Automobile Workshop Karaikal are being set up to cater to the needs of the Government Vehicles as well that of the public.

As Transport is public oriented and the services are to be provided in a timely manner to the public. All the activities of the Department have to be Computerised and adequate man power have to be provided. This is the main target aimed to be achieved fully under the first scheme of strengthening of the Transport Department during the Tenth Five year plan period. Secondly safety of the road users has now gained more importance thanks to enormous growth of vehicle population over the past few years. To promote awareness among public on Road safety measures, a separate "Road safety cell" is proposed to be set up under the second scheme. Seminars, conduct of road safety weeks, conduct of elocution competition among school children, posters, placards containing road safety slogans are the ways by which awareness on road safety is proposed to be promoted in the minds of public.

Setting up of check posts at border areas in Pondicherry and Karaikal regions has been conceived as an important tool to achieve increase in revenue collection and to plug the loophole in tax evasion by vehicle owners of local and other states. A scheme viz. "Strengthening of revenue collection machinery" is proposed which aims to achieve increase in revenue collection mainly through the setting up of these check posts.
