EDUCATION

School Education

Education plays a vital role in the economic, social and cultural development of a country. Besides, moulding characters and values of the citizens, the overall growth of the country depends entirely on educational growth. Hence, in any development plan education is given top priority among all social activities. In so far as the Union Territory of Pondicherry is concerned education has been placed in a better position due to top priority given by this Administration.

As per the 2001 census figure, the literacy rate in the Union Territory of Pondicherry is 81.49 % as against the National average of 65.38 %. This Union Territory has been placed under category-IV having literacy rate of 75 % and above and is in the 7th place in the ranking of literacy rate among States / Union Territories. The task before this Union Territory is to achieve 90 % literacy rate by the end of Tenth Plan and 100 % literacy rate by 2012. To provide compulsory elementary education in the Union Territory, The Pondicherry Compulsory Elementary Education Act 2000 (Act No.8 of 2001) has been enacted on 05.10.2001.

Under Vocational Education, out of 43 Govt. Higher Secondary Schools, 20 Higher Secondary Schools offer 45 vocational courses in various disciplines like agriculture, health & paramedical, engineering technology, home science and Business and Commerce. The enrolment in vocational education in the U.T. of Pondicherry is 16.22 % as against 10 % suggested by the National Policy on Education 1986.

The programme envisaged during the Annual Plan 2006-07 are Under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan the following activities will be taken up (i) Repair & maintenance grant to 490 schools (ii) School grant to 529 schools, (iii) Teachers grant to 4812 Teachers (iv) Supply of teaching learning Equipments to 13 schools (v) 12 day Training to 5217 Teachers (vi) 2 day Training to 1524 community leaders (vii) Assistance to 2360 disabled children

(viii) Enrolment of 1600 out of school children in Alternative school and (ix) Supply of computers to 100 primary schools.

Under free supply scheme 140145 OEBC students and 46133 S.C students will be benefited. Number of beneficiaries under OEBC scholarship and Incentive award to +2 students will be 16,600 students and 1540 students respectively. Under Sports a new component "Nutritional Diet for the development of Talented students in Games / Sports at school level in Govt. Schools" has been proposed. It is anticipated that about 10,000 students will be benefited under above programme. Matching contribution will be released as State Share to the new centrally sponsored scheme. "Information and Communication Technology at Schools", 118 schools will be covered under the new programme.

Collegiate and Technical Education

Under Collegiate Education, there are 6 colleges in the U.T. of Pondicherry of which two colleges are exclusively for Women. In addition to that one PG Centre, namely Kanchi Mamunivar Centre for Post Graduate Studies is being run by the Govt. In view of the need to effect an all round improvement in the colleges, during the Tenth Five Year Plan(2002-2007), the main emphasis will be on the consolidation & expansion of facilities in the existing colleges. New courses in the emerging areas will be started. The existing courses will be redesigned to meet the demands of better specialization.

In order to meet the increasing demand under higher education(Collegiate level) and to create more employment opportunities, new colleges with more job oriented courses were started by Union Territory of Pondicherry Arts, Science and Technology Colleges Society. There are four colleges are being run by the Society. One B.Ed. College is functioning under the aegis of U.T. of Pondicherry College of Education Society, to impart teacher education course with high standard and caliber.

Under technical education, one Engineering College and five Polytechnic Colleges are functioning under the Government. PIPMATE is established to impart Post Matric Technical Education and training in various Engineering subjects and make it sensitive and relevant to the changing Industrial Technological Social Environment trends and to assist for maintaining four polytechnics.

Law College

During 2006-07 it is proposed to start a 3 year full time LLB course for degree holders, another branch in LLM and Post Graduate Diploma course.

Art and Culture

The Union Territory of Pondicherry, the erstwhile French colony has many legacies of art & culture with a rich heritage. One of the prime functions is to establish new libraries, reading rooms besides developing the old libraries for encouraging the literary and reading habits among the general public and also providing facilities for research scholars & students. "Vasagar Vattam" being established in all the Branch Libraries to fulfill the requirements of the reading public. A separate "Children Wing" being established in all the Branch Libraries to develop the reading habit of children and to enable the high school going children too to make use of reference section.

In order to encourage the literary works, research works etc. awards have been instituted in the name of Tamizh Mamani, Puduvai Kalai Mamani, Kamban Pugazh Literary Award, Nehru Childrens' Literary Award, Tholkappier Award and also 'llaignar Mamani' etc.

These awards consist of cash prize and gold coins. Eminent and outstanding artists in the field of literature, music, dance, drama and painting are also honoured with such awards. Financial assistance / grant is being released to indigent Tamil Scholars, artists in the field of letters and arts to uplift the economic conditions of their life. Grant in aid is also being released to voluntary cultural organisations for building grant, maintenance grant financial assistance for publication of manuscript, financial assistance to Dance / Drama Troupes, festival grant and award of Fellowship to research scholars on subjects relation to art and culture. These will be continued during 2006-07.

The remains of Aricamedu and the erstwhile French regime, antiques are being preserved in the Pondicherry Museum. In order to strengthen the Museum, a Toy Museum has been set up. It is proposed to open Nehru Science centre as a part of museum. Restoration of Old light house, Pondicherry will be done and its scientific and architectural heritage will be protected.

An autonomous body in the name of "Bharathiar Palkalaikoodam" has been established in order to provide, graduate studies in the field of music, dance, sculpture etc. Annual grant is also being released. Earlier, the Bharathiar Palkalaikoodam was offering 2 years certificate course which has been upgraded into a degree course. Grant-in-aid is being provided to PILC Grant will be given to M/s. INTACH, Pondicherry Municipality, Pondicherry University and Dravidian University. Construction of Dr.Ambedkar Manimandapam, Bharathiar Manimandapam, Renovation of old Museum and Construction / improvements to libraries will be made.

To develop correct habits among children in the age group of $3\frac{1}{2}$ - 5 years by offering them opportunities for healthy recreation and institutional care. With the objective of giving a proper recognition to early childhood education, which is the first step in the total educational continuum, it is proposed to introduce LKG in 253 Government Primary schools and subsequently UKG during the Tenth Five Year plan. This includes 197 Balawadies to be transferred to Education Department from Social Welfare Department, 38 Govt. pre-primary schools and opening of 18 new pre-primary schools.

The weaker section of the society still find it difficult to send their children to schools, as they are unable to cope up with resulting burden of expenditure. As an incentive to poor students for attracting them to schools at the elementary level, to ensure their retention in the age group 6-14 years and to increase enrolment; textbooks, stationeries, uniforms and foot-wear will be supplied to poor children studying in I-X Stds., subject to the annual parental income of Rs.24,000/- per annum.

3. (a) Actual physical Achievement 2004-05:

Under free supply scheme 1,21,488 OEBC students and 41,429 Scheduled Caste students were benefitted.

(b) Anticipated Physical Achievement 2005-06:

Purchase of dictionaries (English – Tamil in Pondicherry, Karaikal region, English – Malayalam in Mahe region and English – Telugu in Yanam region) for distribution to students in VIII std. in Govt. / Govt. Aided Schools. Identity Cards will be issued to all students from LKG to XII std. in Govt./ Govt. Aided Schools. 1, 33, 472 OEBC and 43,936 SC students will be benefited. Pre-primary students studying in LKG/UKG will also be covered under Free Supply Scheme.

This is a unique festival in the sense that it is being celebrated in all four regions of this Union Territory of Pondicherry viz. Pondy, Karaikal, Mahe and Yanam. Fete de Pondichery, since its inception was being celebrated every year in the month of August to coincide with the "De jure" i.e. the Transfer Day of Pondicherry (16th August) a memorable historic day for the people of Pondicherry. As the month of August is a prone rainy season it was decided to conduct the mega festival during summer season. Chances are given to 100 local artistes / troupes and also to other states of India and thereby providing an interaction between the local and outside troupes which indirectly help to promote National Integration.

Reading rooms will be set up in all the communes of the Union Territory of Pondicherry where there are no branch libraries in existence.

Promotion of traditional martial and heroic arts such as Kalari Payattu, Silambam etc. in the UT of Pondicherry.

2. Objective of the Scheme

The objective is to encourage the troupes / artists performing old traditional arts forms which are in dying stage such as "puppetry", "therukoothu", "karagam", "Kavadiattam" etc. Financial assistance is provided to such troupes / artistes under the scheme. To train the youth in traditional martial and heroic art forms such as "kalari payattu", "silambam" etc by providing financial assistance to the masters of such art forms to improve, develop and preserve such art forms which are part of cultural heritage of the ancient people.

3.(a) Actual physical Achievement 2004-05:

Financial assistance at Rs.2500/- per troupe for 18 troupes had been given to perform open air programme. Financial assistance for the performance of Kalari Payattu / Silambam etc had been given to the 6 troupes who performed activities.

(b) Anticipated Physical Achievement 2005-06:

Financial assistance will be released to 10 troupes who perform old traditional art forms such as puppetry, therukoothu, karagam and kavadi attam which are in dying stage and financial assistance will be provided to 10 persons performing kalarai Payattu, silambam etc. by providing financial assistance to the master of such art form. Financial assistance at Rs. 3500/- per troupe for 30 troupes is proposed to be given.

(c) Programme envisaged for Annual Plan 2006-07:

Financial assistance will be given to 35 troupes / artists who perform old traditional art forms such as puppetry, therukoothu, karagam and kavadi attam and financial assistance to 10 troupes / masters will be granted to perform traditional martial and heroic art forms such as kalari payattu, silambam etc.

2. Objective of the Scheme

To promote cultural and research activities in the field of literary arts, fine arts plastic arts, performing arts as well as historic research by way of providing financial assistance to voluntary cultural organisations and research scholars in the form of grant-in-aid and fellowship.

3.(a) Actual physical Achievement 2004-05:

- i. Financial assistance to voluntary cultural organisations were given for the maintenance / Festival / dance & drama grant.
- ii. Financial assistance for publication of manuscript / research journals to 40 authors were given.

(b) Anticipated Physical Achievement 2005-06:

- Assistance to voluntary cultural organisations for the construction of building. Under this scheme, grant is given for construction of new building, extension of existing building or improvement thereto upto 50% of the cost of structure or Rs.25000/- which ever is less.
- ii. Maintenance grant to institution or organisations engaged in cultural activities. Payment of grant as follows:
 - a) The grant shall not ordinarily exceed 50% of its net expenditure or Rs. 3000/- whichever is less.
- iii. The award of fellowship to research scholars for pursuing higher studies / research and subject relating to art & culture
 - (a) The scholars will be given RS. 1500/- per month for all the 24 months. In addition to, such research scholar shall be given a contingency grant of RS.5000/- per annum equal to that of Bharathidasan and Bharathiar fellowship. The assistance is granted for 2 years. However the duration may be extended for one more year in exceptional case.
- iv. Financial assistance to publication of manuscript / research journals.
 - (a) The maximum amount of grant shall not exceed Rs.3000 in each case.
- v. Financial assistance for dance and drama troupes / associations.
 - (a) The grant shall not exceed Rs.2000/- in each case.
- vi. Financial assistance for cultural organisation for holding conference, seminar, symposium, exhibition, festival competition etc. The amount of grant shall not exceed Rs.5000/- in each case.
- vii. Grant-in-aid / Financial Assistance to Pondicherry Municipality for modernisation of Kamban Kalai Arangam. (New Component)

- i. Assistance to voluntary cultural organisations for the construction of building. Under this scheme, grant is given for construction of new building, extension of existing building or improvement thereto upto 50% of the cost of structure or Rs.25,000/- which ever is less.
- ii. Maintenance grant to institution or organisations engaged in cultural activities. Payment of grant as follows:
 - a) The grant shall not ordinarily exceed 50% of its net expenditure or Rs. 3,000/- whichever is less.
- iii. The award of fellowship to research scholars for pursuing higher studies / research and subject relating to art & culture
 - (a) The scholars will be given Rs. 1,500/- per month for all the 24 months. In addition to, such research scholar shall be given a contingency grant of RS.5,000/- per annum equal to that of Bharathidasan and Bharathiar fellowship. The assistance is granted for 2 years. However the duration may be extended for one more year in exceptional case.
- iv. Financial assistance to publication of manuscript / research journals.
 - (a) The maximum amount of grant shall not exceed Rs.3,000 in each case.
- v. Financial assistance for dance and drama troupes / associations.
 - (a) The grant shall not exceed Rs.2,000/- in each case.
- vi. Financial assistance for cultural organisation for holding conference, seminar, symposium, exhibition, festival competition etc. The amount of grant shall not exceed Rs.,5000/- in each case. In the case of language based cultural organisation an amount of Rs.10,000/- shall be released.
