CO-OPERATIVE

The Pondicherry State Co-operative Housing Federation Ltd. is the Apex Institution for the primary Co-operative Housing Societies. Pondicherry State Co-operative Housing Federation Ltd. is issuing loans to the Primary Co-operative Housing Societies to facilitate issue of loans to their members. It helps the members of the societies, selecting proper lands and to develop lay outs with all infrastructures. During the year 2006-07 more members will be benefited under the scheme by providing finance to the tune of Rs.469.05 lakhs.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING

The housing problems in the Union Territory of Pondicherry continue to be daunting in terms of large number of houseless households and as well as the quality of existing stock.

During the Annual Plan 2006-07, it is proposed to undertake development of 200 Nos. of EWS plots, construction of 200 tenements, construction of 120 LIG houses, to impart training to 150 Trainees, to construct 7500 houses, construction of 375 houses with 5 toilet blocks, and to construct 3000 latrines.

ADI DRAVIDAR WELFARE

House construction subsidy is given to 780 SC people to construct the houses in their own plot. The financial assistance in the form of subsidy to the tune of Rs.50,000/- is extended to them with a view to enable them to construct a house of their own. The subsidy is being given in three instalments based on the stages of construction and also it is proposed to cover 800 SC homeless people.

SURVEY AND LAND REFORMS

Under Survey and Land Reforms, it is proposed to distribution of free house sites to the landless poor in rural areas", with the target fixed as 1200 units. Under the scheme, "Rural House construction scheme", subsidy grant to the eligible beneficiaries with the target fixed as 1000 during the financial year and under the PMGY scheme with the target fixed as 55 nos. In respect of the scheme, Conversion of thatched huts into semi pucca/pucca house is proposed.

D.R.D.A.

Under DRDA housing a subsidy of Rs.50,000/- is given to eligible BPL families to construct their own houses. 333 beneficiaries is proposed to be covered under this programme in the Annual Plan 2006-07.
