SOCIAL WELFARE

Welfare of the disabled requires a multi-sectoral project which includes the right to food, clothing, shelter, preventive and primary health care, medical treatment and assistance, educational and training facilities, job opportunities, social security, aids and appliances etc., leading to their rehabilitation. Providing all normal basic human rights enjoyed by all citizens to the disabled and their integration into the community is also relevant in this regard.

Approach of Eleventh Five Year Plan would be towards the total rehabilitation of the disabled with emphasis on establishing a full-fledged rehabilitation centers in all the regions which will provide adequate medical care and assistance for the disabled, providing skill development by means of establishing Vocational Training Centres, promoting sports and extra-curricular activities among the disabled.

As a part of the institutional development, it is proposed to upgrade the existing Special School for Visually Handicapped and Hearing Impaired at Pillaichavady into a Higher Secondary School. The School is proposed to modernise with barrier free environment, Braille library and other modern equipments for the welfare of the students. A computer-training center will be established for the blind students. District Rehabilitation Centre will be developed into a full-fledged composite fitment center by providing calipers, crutches, hearing aids, walking sticks, wheel chairs, etc. The Centre will be developed into a model center where the entire fitment needs of the disabled can be met. Indoor Stadium will be established for the handicapped to promote sports among the disabled hereby boosting their self-confidence. Recreation club will be developed for the welfare of the handicapped, which will serve as a mini-library-cum-sports-cum-entertainment center for the handicapped. The physically handicapped persons are in need of medical and surgical assistance especially for those who are polio affected, cleft palate, cataract, ear operations etc. Therefore, it is proposed to reimburse the cost of operations for physically handicapped persons, removal of family annual income ceiling of Rs.24,000/- in respect of mentally handicapped children, to increase the financial assistance to physically handicapped persons and to enhance the quantum of free rice to disabled persons.

As a part of the welfare activity of the Social Welfare Department, grants are provided to the Voluntary Organisations, especially those involved in the welfare of the children and Organisations which are running residential Homes for the welfare of the children, old age people, handicapped, street children, terminally ill patients etc. It is proposed to enhance the grant-in aid released to Volantary Organisations.

As a part of our commitment to the senior citizens, it is proposed to open more Old Age Home, especially in the rural areas to provide a peacefully secure and healthy old age life. It is proposed to construct Old Age Home, Beggar Home and Blind Home at Vengateswara Nagar and also a Home for Mentally Retarded Children at Saradambal Nagar. As a part of the welfare programmes, it is proposed to distriute 21" Colour Television to all BPL families who do not own a Color Television. Around, 80,000 families are expected to benefit from the programme over a period of three years.

2. Objective of the Scheme

To strengthen the Directorate of Social Welfare as well as the Sub-Offices in the outlaying regions by creation of posts, in order to cope up the increased work load, owing to expansion of welfare activities. During the Eleventh Five Year plan period 2007-2012 construction of Office Complex in respect of Puducherry region is to be undertaken. Construction of own building for all the Institutions of this Department run in the rented premises is also to be undertaken.

To make the administration of this Department to keep pace with the growing needs and the requirements of the Disabled Persons, Senior Citizens and the Weaker Sections of the Society with speedy processing and implementation of the schemes, it is proposed to computerize the entire functioning of this Department. Through e-Governance initiatives accurate and correct information about the beneficiaries could be easily ascertained and verified. In order to enable to have easy access to the various benefits extended by this Department and also to know the details of the schemes implemented, it is proposed to initiate various steps under this scheme so as to fully computerize all the data available. It is also proposed to conduct a Censes of the Disabled Parsons in the Union Territory, besides issuing identity cards to all Disabled persons. As more than Rs.20 Crores is distributed in a year as Financial Assistance to the Disabled Persons, about 75,000 Old Aged persons are issued with Blankets and Chappals and 20,000 Disabled persons are to be supllied with Sarees and Dhothies, it is necessary to computerize the eligibility lists, etc. immediately. For the purpose, the creation of the posts of programmer and Data Entry Operators are contemplated.

Homes for Orthopaedically Handicapped children are run at Pondicherry and Karaikal regions. The aim is to give education and treatment to Physically handicapped children. The inmates are provided with free boarding and lodging. Vocational training programmes are organised for the children of the age group between 12 and 18 years, during their free hours, so as to make them gain proficiency in select trades/crafts. This training will be organised with the help of private institutions/non Government Organisations.

Through the Home for Visually Handicapped and Hearing Impaired, free education is provided to the visually handicapped and hearing impaired children upto 10th Standard and train them in vocal and instrumental music. The inmates are provided with free boarding and lodging, medical and educational facilities. It is proposed to construct staff quarters, store room, auditorium, hearing aid laboratory and workshop. Every year 10 new inmates will be admitted in each of home at Puducherry and Karaikal.

A Home for Mentally Retarded Children is functioning in Puducherry with 25 inmates. Free boarding, lodging, clothing, medical care, education and other facilities will be provided to them. The aim of the scheme is to provide medical treatment to the admitted mentally retarded children.
