#### WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT

Children constitute the vibrant core of society. Programmes for welfare of children intend to cover those children not covered by any other schemes and aims to given them care and protection along with entertainment, encouragement and appreciation of their talent.1650 children were benefited trough celebration of children's day and conduct of social service camps during the year 2005-06 and the same is anticipated for the years 2006-07 and 2007-08. During 2007-08 it is proposed to constitute "State commission for children ".

The Scheme "Other programme for the welfare of women" encompasses 12 components to benefit the various strata of Women. In the year 2005-06, 304 No.s of Widow's Daughters, 3 widows, 1411 pregnant women, 1964 lactating women and 210 poor brides were benefited by financial assistance through the various components of the above scheme. In the year of 2006-07 the quantum of financial assistance is further increased and number of women are anticipated to be benefited. Further two new components were added during 2006-07 to encourage parents to adopt birth control measures after giving birth to two girl children and Parents having only one girl child studying 8<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> standard by supporting them financially. 23 Families were benefited through this scheme. Apart from providing financial assistance, the scheme also aims at imparting general awareness and entrepreneurship among women folk by celebrating Women's Day, Women's Week, conducting "Swayamsidha Fair" and helping to form Self Help Groups under "Mangalam Society". An estimated 4500 women participated in the above programmes during the year 2005-06. As a whole it is targeted by the Department to cover 12500 women under the above scheme.

The state commission for Welfare of women has been constituted with a Chairperson and 6 members. In order to provide comfortable, and secure stay for women who are working in places away from their homes at low cost, hostels for working women are functioning in Pondicherry, Karaikal covering 65 inmates. Further 25 women will be covered under the rehabilitation programme for AIDS victims. The Family Counselling Centers run by the Department have given valuable suggestions, advice and guidance to as much as 250 cases with problems in the family during last year. The Women Development Corporation that is the channelising agency for financial aid for women to set up their own enterprises with the Government Share and the target proposed is 2500 during 2007-08.

During the Eleventh Five Year Plan Period, 79,283 Old Age persons, Widows and destitute women are to be provided a monthly assistance at an enhanced rate of Rs.600/-. 300 OAP beneficiaries are to be provided Rs.500/- as medical assistance. A new scheme of free supply of rice @ 10 Kg per month per family will be also be extended irrespective of their family including all old age people as a part of welfare measures. The scheme of free supply of saree, blouse, lungi and towel sets to all poor people will be continued. 28519 children and 9210 mothers are to be provided supplementary nutrition under ICDS scheme. It is proposed to build permanent buildings to Anganwadis functioning in rented buildings in the Eleventh Five Year Plan 2007-12. Proposed to acquire land for construction of buildings for Directorate of Women and Child Development and 4 ICDS project offices. Proposed to purchase of four-wheelers to the department.

Children's Day will be celebrated. Social service camp will be conducted. Expansion of Hostels for Working Women will be taken up in a phased manner both in Puducherry and Karaikal Districts. It is proposed to start a training centre to Anganwadi workers/helpers. Financial assistance is to be enhanced at the rate of Rs.20,000/- per women under the scheme Marriage allowance to daughter of widows. It is proposed to enhance the financial assistance to of Rs.1000 to the pregnant women for six months under the 'Kulavilaku' scheme and Rs.1,200 to lactating women under 'Aravanaippu' scheme. The two schemes 'Kulavilaku' and 'Aravanaippu' are merged into one scheme.

The scheme providing financial assistance to the parents who have absorbed small family norms immediately after delivery of one female issue, has now been extended to the parents who have undergone family planning after the birth of the two girl children @ Rs.7,500/- to each in the form of fixed deposit. An amount of Rs. 10,000/- which was given as financial assistance for performance of marriage of poor girls and for marriage of daughters of widows and destitutes, have been enhanced to Rs. 15,000/- from 2004-05.
