INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AND E-GOVERNANCE

Separate Directorate of Information Technology has been created under Planning and Research Department in the year 2002 to give push to IT related activities in the U.T. of Puducherry. As a result various of initiatives taken by the Directorate of Information Technology, computerization has taken place in almost all Government departments and Personal Computer has became a vital tool to carryout day to day activities effectively in all government departments.

The Directorate of Information Technology (DIT) has now taken up, promoting IT and ITES services to tap potential for creations job opportunities within UT of Puducherry. Through various incentives which includes (i) Development of IT parks, (ii) Offering attractive incentives to IT and IT related industries to choose Puducherry as destination for starting IT Industries and software development units. Private participation in IT related services will be encouraged. It is also proposed to setup a separate society for creating Infrastructural Development in all the four regions of U.T exclusively for promotion of IT related services in this Union Territory.

e-Governance is an important instrument for improving governance and make it more citizen friendly and transparent. e-Governance requires high quality IT infrastructure, networking capabilities and adequate support and skilled technical manpower available at all levels. Hence, as a part of e-Governance initiatives it is proposed to establish:

- 1. Puducherry State Wide Area Network (PSWAN)
- 2. State Data Centre
- 3. Establishment of e-group services
- 4. Setting up of Rajiv Gandhi Knowledge centre
- 5. Setting up of Jawahar Knowledge centre
- 6. Common Service Centers.
- 7. Training to Government officials and students from Government Schools.
- 8. Appointment/Selection of consultant for implementing various
- 9. e-Governance initiatives.
- 10. Strengthening of Directorate of Information Technology.

Some of the core applications, such as School Administration and management system, Employee payroll and HRMS, Accounts, Finance, Purchase and Inventory, GIS based applications and various Department specific application softwares will be developed by outsourcing technical expertise. The Puducherry e-Governance services (PEGS) will be utilized for implementation of various mission mode e-governance projects, training, Software Development, Web services etc. The services of National Informatics Centre, Puducherry unit may also be utilized for development of application software.

Utility services in Municipalities, Commune panchayat, Electricity, PWD, Civil Supplies, Transport, Revenue, Commercial Taxes, Police, Welfare, Judicial courts will be computerized for quick redressal of the problems that citizen face. e-Governance will also lead to transparency, accountability and speed in the procurement/ tendering process.

Online availability of various certificates will also be provided. Payment of electricity bill, water tax, sales tax, house tax, property tax etc. through the electronic mode would became reality during the 11th plan in the U.T. of Puducherry.

In close coordination with Directorate of School Education computerization process will be extended upto primary school level in all government schools. Computer related training through private institutes will be encouraged such that employment potential at the level of Higher Secondary Education and beyond to cope up with expression skills in foreign languages such as Japanese, German, French and so on and steps will be taken to ensure that IT is affordable and within the reach of the common man. During the Annual Plan 2008-09, completion of PSWAN implementation, setting up of State Data Centre, implementation of Common Service Centre, Capacity Building, e-tendering, e-district, Rajiv Gandhi Knowledge Park, Land acquisition for IT Park, Jawahar Knowledge Centre, e-Grievance Cell are proposed. In addition, setting up of GIS, Audit Cell, Unit offices at outlying region, setting up of software development cell, mission mode project, strengthening of Dte. of IT, appointment of consultant are proposed. Training to government officials, providing training and capacity building through Puducherry e-Governance Society.

2. Objective of the Scheme :

The Objectives of the scheme is to make all the Government officials of ministerial cadre as computer literate by imparting training on Office Automation to satisfy their needs in official computer operations and to offer specialized training to Government officials as and when necessity arises. It is also proposed to adopt the best practices found in other states and roll out the same for the beneficiaries of student communities.

Jawahar Knowledge Centre (JKC):-

In order to give a fillip to I.T. activities of Directorate, it is propose to fill up one full time Director(IT) for full fledged Departmental functioning, including cadre controlling. Apart from this, in order to take up various e-Governance projects as per the norms of the National E-Governance Plan (NeGP) in a speedy and transparent way, this Directorate proposed to enhance the existing manpower structure at various levels of project management. The detailed structure of the proposal is enclosed.

State Data Centre: Government of Puducherry is embarking on a statewide automation of its operations and implementing e-Governance initiatives, all the departments would need to maintain servers for the respective applications. Managing these servers / infrastructure would require investing in substantial dedicated resources at each department / location. The Data Center would provide a centralized location for hosting and managing all the servers and result in substantial cost savings for GoP with improved infrastructure facility. With the falling costs of communication, centralized architecture becomes a reality. This would call for a facility that provides a platform for effective management of information assets being created by GoP, as a part of its e-governance initiatives.
