## **EDUCATION**

#### **SCHOOL EDUCATION**

Education plays a vital role in the economic, social and cultural development of a country. Besides, moulding character and values of the citizen, the overall growth of the country depends entirely on educational growth. Hence, in any development plan education is given top priority among all social services. In so far as the Union Territory of Puducherry is concerned education has been placed at a higher pedestal due to top priority given by this Administration.

Launching of Rajiv Gandhi Breakfast Scheme extended up to 12<sup>th</sup> Standard, benefiting about 1,26,000 students including children of pre-primary classes is the first of its kind in India. Mid-day Meals Scheme is extended upto 12<sup>th</sup> standard including pre-primary children. 300 out of school children have been enrolled in Alternative Schools leaving out 260 children only to be traced and enrolled. The Public examination fees to the extent of Rs. 36,10,000/- for SSLC / +2 / Intermediate public examination held in March / April 2007 has been paid by the Govt. to Board of Secondary Education, Chennai, Kerala and Andhra Pradesh. New Astro-turf for Hockey Stadium of International standard will be commissioned in the Indira Gandhi Stadium, Uppalam, shortly.

To give special focus on SC children, components like 'Night School' and 'Special Coaching Classes for Slow Learners' have been successfully implemented.

Literacy Rate in the Union Territory of Puducherry

As per the 2001 census, the literacy rate of Union Territory of Puducherry is 81.49% as against the National average of 65.38% Puducherry has been placed under category-IV having literacy rate of 75% and above and is in the 7<sup>th</sup> place in the ranking of literacy rate among States / Union Territories. The task before this Union Territory is to achieve 100% literacy rate by 2012. In order to ensure universal access to primary education, Compulsory Education Act has been implemented since 2001. The following table shows regionwise literacy rate:

#### Out of School Children

School is an important factor in a child's development. The Sarva Siksha Abhiyan already aim at providing elementary education to all children in the 6-14 years age group. Children from socially disadvantaged families often have learning difficulties among other things. Their vocabulary is limited. Special help in pre-primary schools can help them overcome this handicap.

Due to efforts under Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan in enrolling out-of-school children in 'Alternative Schools' and mainstreaming them in regular schools after making them achieve adequate skills. Drop out in schools have come to a minimum only.

#### **Education Institutions**

There are 432 numbers of schools under Govt. 34 schools are getting Grant-in-aid from the Govt. There are 220 un-aided schools in the Union Territory of Puducherry. The available infrastructure in Govt. Schools is still insufficient to meet the children's demands. To strengthen these schools, additional allocation is required for construction of pucca buildings with all facilities like toilet, water facilities, play ground, providing furniture etc.,

Sarva Siksha Abhiyan, for the universalisation of Elementary Education in a mission mode was launched in the Union Territory of Puducherry during 2002. These Schemes aim at providing quality elementary education for all children in the age group 6-14 by 2010 and to bridge the social, regional and gender gaps.

To improve quality of education all teachers will be given intensive training both in subject content and its transaction in the classroom. They will also be given yearly grants for preparing Teaching-learning materials. The "monitoring and evaluation" system will also be strengthened to provide a good quality education. In this regard the existing State Training Centre will be converted as "State Council for Education, Research and Training".

The "District Institute of Education and Training (DIET)" will be brought under state plan with 50% state share to give more training to Teachers.

It is proposed to give financial assistance to the tune of Rs. 250 per annum for the students studying from 6<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> standard in Government schools.

The task before the Government is to strengthen the existing system and find out various new sources and technology to improve **the quality of education, retention of students and ultimately achieve cent per cent literacy rate.** To achieve 100% literacy in this U.T. "Kamaraj Literacy Mission" has been formed.

#### Drop out:

The Drop Out Rate for Elementary Education, which stood at 1.97 during 2001-02 as per the Selected Educational Statistics published by the Department of Secondary & Higher Education, Ministry of Human Resources Development, New Delhi has come down to zero during 2002-03, in respect of this Union Territory. Similarly, based on the Enrolment Data for the year 2003-04, 2004-05 & 2006-07 the drop out rate at Elementary Stage for the above period continues to be zero. This means that all the students in the age group 6 to 13 are completely enrolled and continued their studies upto 8<sup>th</sup> standard. That is possible due to various measures taken by this administration in ensuring retention and reduce the dropout. Various Incentive / Welfare Schemes such as free supply of books, stationery, uniforms, footwear, umbrellas, rain coats, pre-matric scholarship to OEBC students, free mid-day meals, breakfast and Shri Rajiv Gandhi Evening Milk Scheme etc have contributed a lot to achieve zero percent drop out at Elementary Stage and ensure retention.

#### Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education

The schools either Govt. or Private in Puducherry and Karaikal regions have affiliation to the Board of Education in Tamilnadu and schools in Mahe and Yanam to the Boards of Kerala and Andhra Pradesh respectively. The curricula, syllabi and textbooks of these states are followed. The public examinations are also conducted by the respective Boards of Education. In order to have uniform curricula and syllabi and to improve standard of Education it was resolved to set up a **separate Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education**. Accordingly the Pondicherry Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education was established in January 2006. The Board of studies for Pre-Primary Education has also been formed. The curriculum for L.K.G. & U.K.G. classes have been developed.

## Sports:

The Directorate of School Education is implementing various sports developmental activities for the better performance of the students in schools and colleges as well as youth. The main objectives of this sports development activities are to develop the Physical health of the students by way of conducting yearly tournaments and so many competitions giving cash awards, medals and certificates etc., Construction/improvement of existing sports stadium in all the four regions, Construction of mini stadium at commune level for which land is yet to be acquired for want of funds.

#### Vocational Education:

Vocationalisation of Secondary Education is a major objective of the reforms envisaged in the education policy adopted in 1986. The introduction of systematic and well planned programme of Vocational Education is crucial in the proposed educational reorganization.

- i. To enhance individual employability,
- ii. To reduce mismatch, knowledge and skills for entrepreneurship and self employment.
- iii. To develop attitudes, knowledge and skills for entrepreneurship and self employment.

Not only does vocational education offer meaningful alternative to general education but helps in increased productivity and the economy as well.

#### Objectives:

- i. Development of Vocational Programmes at all levels.
- ii. Laying guidelines for Vocational Education.
- iii. Development of bridges / transfer of courses / entrepreneurship Counseling.
- iv. To reduce the mismatch between demand and supply of skilled manpower.
- v. To provide diversification of educational Opportunities.
- vi. To provide on alternative for those perusing higher education.

The following measures have been taken for the effective functioning of the vocational education as far as the Union Territory of Puducherry is concerned.

- 1. The State Council of Vocational Education (SCVE) and District Vocational Education Committee (DVEC) have been constituted for effective implementation of Vocational Education in the Union Territory of Puducherry.
- 2. Recently from Pandit Sunderlal Sharma Central Institute of Vocational Education (PSSCIVE), Bhopal a Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India organization to monitor the Vocational Education in all **the** states, organized a preliminary meeting on District Vocational Education and Training Survey with Principals / Vice Principals and Instructors on 8<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> October 2007 in the Conference Hall, Directorate of School Education, Puducherry.
- 3. Vocational Survey to be conducted to identify the availability / demand in the employment opportunity and wage earning potentiality / self-employment and to introduce the need based Vocational courses in the particular areas where the schools are located. Two or more courses shall be introduced every year in the selected schools to meet out the skilled manpower, which is more need in coming years.
- 4. During the 11<sup>th</sup> Plan each year two or three demand based Vocation Courses to be introduced in both Urban and rural areas, so as to meet skilled manpower requirements of existing and new industrial units in the Union Territory of Puducherry. Also new vocational courses may be introduced in Mahe and Yanam regions during the coming academic year.

## **HIGHER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION**

"Education is the critical factor that will empower the poor to participate in the growth process".

"In our situation, access for the mass of our people can only be assisted through a Substantial effort at public financing of these services"

"To ensure a continuous and growing supply of quality manpower, we need large investments in public sector institution of **higher learning** combined with fundamental **reforms of curriculum**".

These categorical statements in the approach paper of XI Five Year Plan, clearly provide the directions for planning the higher education programmes.

There is clearly a need to undertake major expansions and improve quality. For this, new colleges and Universities must be set up to provide easier access to students in educationally backward districts. Existing institutions must be strengthened and expanded, along with open and distance education modes.

Hence, it is planned to setup the Puducherry State University which would provide extended higher educational facilities especially to the students from middle and lower income groups and backward and underprivileged sections of people.

An Engineering College will be planned in Karaikal, a backward region of the territory and to increase employability and jobs seeking capacity a Community College with job oriented courses will be set up in Karaikal.

Expanded programmes of higher and research education will be planned in different regions to reduce regional imbalances and to reduce backwardness.

The new Puducherry State University planned during the Eleventh Five Year Plan, would be able to revamp the entire curriculum so that it could improve the quality of education competencies and would also make the curriculum relevant for job opportunities. Additional components to increase the skills and competences of the students, so that they could become employable in and around Puducherry to support other socio-economic developmental programmes of the Puducherry Union Territory. In this regard, Entrepreneurial Development courses, Add on Courses, and new Vocational Courses are planned. Private and Public Sector participation would be encouraged in setting up premier institutions of Information Technology and Management.

Efforts would be taken to provide for infrastructural facilities in the form of latest books, use of more computer, internet and EDUSAT services and creation of resource centres for various disciplines / departments.

In order to augment these facilities, electronically content and testing mechanism would also be utilised by developing suitable materials.

By gradually increasing the quality of education in all institutions, the institutions would be encouraged to seek NAAC accreditation in due courses.

## LAW

During the Eleventh Five Year Plan, it is proposed to start a 3 year full time LLB course for degree holders, another branch in LLM and Post Graduate Diploma Course.

# **ART & CULTURE**

The Union Territory of Puducherry, the erstwhile French colony has many legacies of art & culture with a rich heritage. Separate Directorate for Art and Culture has been established in order to develop the arts, literature, political legacies and remembrance of great poets. Romain Rolland Library, Public Branch Libraries (80 Nos.), Bharathiar, Bharathidasan, Subbaiah, Toy, French, Kizhour and Puducherry Museums and autonomous institutions like Bharathiar Palkalaikoodam and Pondicherry Institute of Linguistics Centre come under the purview of the Department of Art & Culture. No. of vizhas and workshops were successfully conducted and awards are given to the meritorious/outstanding artist in

various filed to encourage literary and research works etc.,. Financial assistance are given to the persons distinguished in letters/performing visual arts etc., to uplift the economic condition of their life. Further the Department is preserving the records/publications and strengthening the archives. GIA are released to Bharathiar Palkalaikoodam, Pondicherry Institute of Linguistic and Culture and M/s.INTACH, Pudhucherry every year for the overall development of Art and Cultural activities of the Puducherry. Voluntary Cultural organisation are assisted and fellowship Awards granted to the research scholars for pursuing higher studies in the filed of Art and Culture.

It is proposed to establish State Level Hi-Tech library with all modern facilities at Puducherry and digitization of Branch libraries to encourage the literary and reading habits among the general public and students. Purchase of computers will be done in a phased manner and supplied to all Public and Branch libraries. Necessary steps have been taken to open more branch libraries to inculcate reading habit among the rural public by relaxing the existing distance and population norms. Action on hand to computerize the public and Branch Libraries and also digitize rare and old documents available in the Romain Rolland Lib. and various meuseums. Establishment of "Children Learning Park" in Romain Rolland Library and other public libraries so as to make the libraries more children freindly. Action has been taken to accommodate all libraries functioning in rented buildings to Govt. owned buildings with infrastructural facilities including Women and Children Wing. Starting of Medium Level Public Libraries (Commune Headquarters) in six places viz. Kadirgamam, Villianur, Bahour, Thirukkanur, Nettapakkam and Nedungadu (Karaikal). Action being taken to arrange accommodation and to get administrative approval.

Historic, Memorial and Scientific Museum will be established at Karaikal. Acquisition of land adjacent to Kizhoor historical monument for development and beautification of the monument so as to make it as a tourist spot, with a children amusement park. Action is being taken to strengthen the Toys/ French Museum the Mahakavi Bharathiar Museum, Pavendar Bharathidasan Museum and Puducherry Museum. Renovation of Amarar V. Subbiah and Tmt. Saraswathy Subbiah Social, Science, Literary and Memorial Museumcum- Research Centre, Puducherry. Construction of Dr. Ambedkar Manimandam work going properly and proposal getting ready for the construction of Vanidassan Manimandapam at Seliamedu. Action being taken to host a Website exclusively for the Department of art & Culture. Making of documentary of the poets and freedom fighters on their life history and distribution of the same to all schools. Establishment of Sale-cum-display gallery to encourage the Artists. Formation of Society for co-ordinating various development activities of Art & Culture Department, to promote the unpopular art forms and to take immediate action to make them avail the benefits / opportunities available under various schemes. In general, the Directorate of Art & Culture is functioning as a ladder for the general public to know about the history, legacy and life styles of great poets and patriots and the world around them, besides encouraging artists in various fields and also preserving the antiques of Puducherry.
