

## **DAIRY DEVELOPMENT**

The main objective of the Dairy Development Programme are:-

- i. Remuneration milk marketing and development of milch cattle to improve the socio- economic conditions of the milk producers.
- ii. To maintain an effective supply system of milk and milk products at reasonable price for the consumers.
- iii. To provide subsidiary occupation to farmers to supplement their income and improve their standard of living.

To attain the above objectives, Primary Milk Cooperative Societies have been organized which have taken over the responsibility of the collection of milk from member producer.<sup>97</sup> Primary Cooperative milk producers societies which are in Puducherry are supplying milk by affiliating them with Pondicherry Cooperative Milk Producers' Union Ltd., No.P.1 and 19 primary cooperative milk producers' societies in the Karaikal region and supplying milk to the Karaikal Cooperative Milk Producers' Union Ltd., No.P.8, Karaikal and one primary cooperative milk producers' society in Yanam region is supplying milk to the Govt. Hostels, Hospitals etc.,

Under operation Flood III the Pondicherry Cooperative Milk Producers' Union Ltd., No.P.1, was expanded in handle 50000 litres per day. All the primary cooperative milk producers' societies were converted into Anand Pattern societies with veterinary coverage at the door steps of milk producers. The Pondicherry Cooperative Milk Producers' Union Ltd., No.P.1, is funded by Govt. of Puducherry. The primary Cooperative Milk Producers' societies also started following the Anand Pattern of Milk Procurement from April 2007.

To strengthen the primary cooperative milk Producers societies in Puducherry a sum of Rs.18.00 lakhs was released during the year 2006-07. A sum of Rs.100.00 lakhs has been released to the Karaikal cooperative Milk Producers' Union.

During the Annual Plan 2007-08 it is proposed to assist the Pondicherry Cooperative Milk Producers' Union by extending financial assistance of Rs.200.00 lakhs for the payment of supporting price to the milk producers' of primary cooperative milk producers' societies, Rs.443.00 lakhs for extending financial assistance for payment of 50% subsidy to the members of Self Help Groups for purchase of milch cows. A sum of Rs.20.00 lakhs has been provided for payment of supporting price to the milk producers' of primary cooperative milk producers' societies in Karaikal region.

During the Annual Plan 2008-09, it is proposed to extend financial assistance to the tune of Rs.300.00 lakhs for payment of supporting price to the milk producers' of primary cooperative milk producers' societies, in Puducherry region a sum of Rs.500.00 lakhs for extending financial assistance for payment of 50% subsidy to the members of Self Help Groups for purchase of milch cows, a sum of Rs. 257.60 lakhs towards reimbursement of cattle feed subsidy claims and Rs.51.40 lakhs as State Share for implementation of the

Centrally Sponsored Schemes -“Strengthening infrastructure for Quality and Clean Milk Production”. It is proposed to extend financial assistance for strengthening of primaries in Puducherry region to an extend of Rs.60.00 lakhs and a sum of Rs.5.00 lakhs to primaries in Karaikal region. It is proposed to extend a sum of Rs.40.00 lakhs as share capital assistance to Karaikal Cooperative Milk Producers’ Union Rs.40.00 lakhs for strengthening Dairy Plant of Karaikal Cooperative Milk Producers’ Union and Rs.20.00 lakhs for payment of supporting price to the milk producers’ of Primary Cooperative Milk Producers’ Societies in Karaikal region. It is also proposed to extend a sum of Rs.2.00 lakhs to the Yanam Cooperative Milk Producers’ Union, Yanam.
