WELFARE OF SCHEDULED CASTES & SCHEDULED TRIBES

The Adi Dravidar Welfare Department is implementing various innovative schemes for the welfare of SC community under the following two categories.

- 1. Schemes for educational improvements, training self-employment to the scheduled castes population.
- 2. Schemes for social and economic development of scheduled caste population.

During the Annual plan 2007-08, about 6000 SC students will be awarded pre-matric scholarship and 8000 SC girls students will be benefited by opportunity cost. 1,66,000 SC people will be given free clothing items. 400 homeless persons will be allotted free house site pattas. It is proposed to assist 350 SC poor brides at the enhanced rate of Rs.50,000/each and 600 pregnant and lactating women at the enhanced rate of Rs.6,000/- (Rs.1,000/p.m. for pre-natal period of 3 months and post-natal period of 3 months). It is also proposed to cover 500 SC students by providing coaching and allied facilities. Grant-in-aid to be released to Local Bodies to take up 30 civic works. In the current financial year construction of 3 more Hostels will be undertaken at Krishna Nagar and Pudupet in Puducherry region and one at Keezhakasakudi in Karikal region. Presently 12 hostels are running in private buildings. Within a period of next three years it is proposed to construct new hostels so that all hostels are run in government buildings. During this year (2007-08) three hostels to be opened, two in Puducherry region at Kadirkamam and Thirukkanur and One in Karaikal region at T.R. Pattinam. All the facilities for the hostel students are to be done properly. The Scholarship is being issued to the students has been increased twice the present level. Travelling Allowance at Rs.20/- per trip for twice a week to III year and IV year Law Students staying at Government SC Hostels is given. Educational Tour to XII Std. and II year ITI students staying at Government SC Hostels has been arranged.

From 1st April 2007 onwards the Scheduled Caste Sub-Plan subject matter is dealt in Adi-Dravidar Welfare Department itself vide G.O. Ms.No.1/PRD/2007 dt.05.02.2007. It is proposed to create various Technical and Ministerial post for the Scheduled Caste Sub-Plan Cell. It is also proposed to set up Revenue and Engineering Cells respectively in this department to carry out the land acquisition work and construction and maintenance of Hostel buildings.
