FORESTRY AND WILDLIFE

Forest is the basis of life which contributes towards environmental, economical & socio economical. Sustainable Management of Forest has been recognized in the Earth summit at Rio and it has been stressed the need for enhancing the tree cover of 25% in the year 2007 and to 33% by 2012 to combat the global warming.

During 2008-09, afforestation in urban rural areas, waste lands, tank beds, banks of rivers, canals, roadside and coastal areas, creation of coastal shelterbelt plantation in Coastal areas and sand dune stabilization, creation of mangrove plantation in the back water areas are thrust areas. Plantation in industrial sites and tree plantation in the farmer's fields will be undertaken.

In order to maximize the production / yield in farm land available improved varieties of plants, clonal and high yielding varieties are to be distributed to the farmers and more area will be brought under the tree cover to achieve the 33% tree cover by 2012. Parks and gardens will be developed in the urban areas as well as rural areas to add green cover and serve dual purpose educative and recreational.

For effective protection and conservation of wildlife and prevent poaching and hunting by Narikurava community an Eco-development project has been formulated. It is proposed that an arboretum comprises of more than 100 species of tree varieties at Manapet and a Botanical Garden will developed at Karaikal as ex-situ conservation proposed under the International bio-diversity convention. To encourage Eco-tourism and attract tourists, developments of Ossudu, Manapet and Thengaithittu Mangroves areas are essential. To motivate the student on Forests and Wildlife Conservation and farmers on Agro-forestry educational tours are arranged to National Parks and Sanctuaries and Forest Research Institute.

It is also proposed to set up Bio-diversity Council, Museum at Swedeshee-Barathi mill campus, Puducherry, recreational parks at Karaikal and Yanam. Financial assistance will be given to promoters who are planting trees in Panchayats.

1. Name of the Scheme : Social Forestry in Panchayats.

2. Objective of the Scheme :

The main objective of the scheme is to provide afforestation activity outside existing forests in urban and rural areas including planting in residential areas, avenue plantations, plantations on unproductive lands etc. as well as for distribution of seedlings to private individuals, institutions, government departments, corporate bodies etc., for creating plantations on private lands and to educate, motivate and involve people in massive afforestation.

1. Name of the Scheme : Preservation, Conservation, Protection

and Development of Forests and

Wildlife.

2. Objective of the Scheme

The main objective of the scheme is to provide for survey, identification and demarcation of the existing forests and wildlife resources in the Union Territory and preparation and implementation of management plans for conservation of such resources. This scheme also provides for anti-poaching, anti-smuggling and preventive activities of the directorate and grant of reward to informers etc. The scheme also provides for arms and ammunition, communication equipment, GIS, GPS vehicles and other material support required for law enforcement, preventive activities and creation of public awareness for protection of forests and wildlife.

As a measure of protection and development of forests and wildlife this department aims at setting up of eco-tourists centre at Thengaithittu Mangrove vegetation area with a Walkway, Manapet forest land as State Arboretum with Bird Watch Tower and Interpretation Centre, Ossudu as a bird sanctuary and Interpretation Centre, establishment of Forest Museum, setting up of Rescued Centre for rescued wild animals and birds, restoration of Sacred grooves in and around Puducherry, conduct studies on Flora and Fauna of Puducherry, establishing turtle breeding and protection centre, development of Mangrove vegetation at Yanam, rehabilitation and eco-development of Narikurava community. Finally, setting up of a Forest Development Agency for the effective implementation of the above mentioned schemes.

A Geographical Information System and GPS will be created for better management, planning, monitoring and use of land resources and the activities of the department which will be made accessible to public through internet.

Preparing extension materials related to Forest and Wildlife, training to the fisherman about the marine wildlife, laying demonstration plots on modern technologies in the farmer's field and creation of parks and gardens in Puducherry, Karaikal and Yanam.

Hence, creation of Coastal shelter belt along the coastal regions of Puducherry and Karaikal was felt necessary and steps are taken to create bio-wall plantation and involve the fisherwomen self help group for the maintenance of the same. So far 54 ha. in Puducherry and 64ha. in Karaikal the Bio wall plantation has been created. Maintenance of the existing plantations, creation of additional plantations were ever lands available planting coconut seedlings front of the houses in villages affected by Tsunami.
