TRANSPORT

(A) GOVERNMENT AUTOMOBILE WORKSHOP

Repairs of both major and minor are being carried out in the Workshop. Besides POL products like fuel lubricants etc., are supplied to all vehicles agriculture machineries equipments etc., belonging to Government and Quasi Government agencies. A similar mini workshop fuelling station and a service station are also functioning in the outlaying Karaikal region to cater to repairs maintenance & services of Government vehicles. Practical in-plant training under the Apprentices act is given to unemployed ITI holders. Diploma holders and Graduate engineers both in the field of engineering and commercial practice to abreast their knowledge and skill in the respective fields. A Motor Vehicle Driving Training Institute is functioning in Puducherry and training to unemployed youths is imparted in driving Light Motor Vehicles and Heavy Motor Vehicles. A Similar Institute is also functioning their knowledge in maintence & skill safe driving. One Emission Under Control Test station each at Government Automobile Workshop, Puducherry& Government Automobile Workshop, Karaikal are being set up to cater to the needs of the Government Vehicles as well that of the public.

PERFORMANCE DURING 2007-08

Imparted Driving training on LMV and HMV to 125 & 27 unemployed youth of Puducherry & Karaikal, respectively.

LIKELY ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2008-09

> To impart Driving Training on LMV & HMV to 150 unemployed youth.

PROPOSED TARGET FOR 2009-10

▶ It is proposed to impart training to 200 LMV & 50 HMV.

(B) TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT

The Transport Department renders services like Issuing Driving Licences, Registration of vehicles, Issue of Permits to Transport Vehicles. Transport Department also takes necessary steps to control and regulate Road Traffic and to suspend/cancel the registration of permit of a motor vehicle, if it poses threat to public safety.

All the remaining activities have to be computerised in all the four regions in order to provide transparent and quick services to the public. During 2009-10, it is proposed to conduct regular pollution test and introduce to the vehicles with latest technique, which will be environmentally friendly one. It has also been proposed to introduce a new scheme laying new railway line between Tindivanam and Cuddalore via Puducherry by releasing state share contribution to the Southern Railway. Like-wise, another one new broad gauge railway line has also been proposed to lay between Nagore and Karaikal. It has been proposed to strengthen the revenue collection machinery by setting up of check-posts at all the entry point to the U.T. of Puducherry. As a first step, it has been proposed to set-up 4 nos. of check-posts (3 nos. in Puducherry region and 1 no. at Karaikal region), for which 36 nos. of posts both technical and ministerial are proposed to be created during the year 2009-10 itself. To intensify the enforcement activities of the department with a view to proper and effective implementation of provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act and Rules. To create awareness among the general public about the road safety by setting up of Road Safety Cell, which will conduct various awareness programmes, seminars and road safety week. To regulate the prevailing traffic conditions in Puducherry, it has been proposed to introduce the Mass Rapid Transport Systems(MRTS).

PERFORMANCE DURING 2007-08

- Celebration of Road Safety week
- Released an amount of Rs. 1 crore as share capital assistance /contribution to Puducherry Road Transport Corporation (PRTC).

LIKELY ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2008-09

- Setting up of check-posts at all entry points to U.T. of Puducherry
- Setting up of check-posts in Puducherry Region at Gorimedu, Madhagadipet, Kanniyakoil and Ambagathur in Karaikal region.

- To release of share contribution (final installment) to the Southern Railways for having completed the gauge conversion and electrification work in the railway line between Villupuram and Puducherry.
- To release of share contributions to the Southern Railways for laying new railway lines between Tindivanam and Cuddalore via Puducherry
- To release of share contribution to the Southern Railways for laying new railway line between Nagore and Kraikal.

PROPOSED TARGET FOR 2009-10

Establishment of Transport Complex which will have the Transport Department Automobile Workshop, vehicle Testing Yard, Fuel bunk and a Model Park at a cost of Rs.20 Crores.
