GOVERNMENT AUTOMOBILE WORKSHOP

In-plant and training under the Apprentices Act is given to unemployed I.T.I holders, Diploma Holders and Graduate Engineers, both in the field of Engineering and commercial practices to abreast their knowledge and skill in the respective fields. A Motor Vehicle Driving Training Institute is functioning in Puducherry and impart unemployed youth in driving Light Motor Vehicles and Heavy Motor Vehicles. A similar Institute is also functioning in Karaikal region. Refresher courses for Govt. drivers are also conducted for updating their knowledge in maintence & skill safe driving. One Emission Control Test Station each at Govt. Automobile Workshop, Puducherry and Karaikal are being set up to cater to the needs of the Govt. vehicles as well as that of the public.

ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2008-09:

➤ Imparted Driving training to 67 nos. of LMV & 40 nos. of HMV to unemployed youth.

LIKELY ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2009-10:

➤ Imparting Driving training 75 nos. of LMV & 50 nos. HMV to unemployed youth.

PROPOSED TARGET FOR 2010-11:

➤ Proposed to impart Driving training to 100 nos. of LMV & 75 nos. of HMV to unemployed youth.

TRANSPORT

In order to provide transparent and quick services to the public, Transport Department has computerized its activities in all the four regions and introduced the system of obtaining pollution test to the vehicles with latest techniques, which is environment-friendly. Proposed to introduce a new scheme of laying new railway line between Tindivanam and Cuddalore via Puducherry by releasing State Share contribution to the Southern Railway. Proposed to strengthen the revenue collection machinery by setting up of check-posts at all the entry point to the U.T. of Puducherry. Proposed to set-up three Check-posts in Puducherry region and one in Karaikal region. Enforcement activities have been intensified by the department

with a view to proper and effective implementation of provisions under Motor Vehicles Act and Rules. Road Safety Cell of the Transport Department has created road safety awareness among the public.

ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2008-2009:

- > Road Safety awareness created among the public by Celebrating Road Safety Week.
- Number of vehicles registered during the year: 46,811 Nos.
- Number of Driving Licenses issued during the year: 22,683 Nos.

- ➤ Introduction of Smart Card In order to provide effective service through latest technology, it is proposed to issue Smart Card for vehicles Registration and Driving Licenses along with the allied Transport Customer Care Services.
- ➤ Proposed to introduce the system of High Security Registration Plate (HSRP) for the vehicles in order to comply with the directions of Government of India.
