HANDLOOMS

Handloom Industry is one of the major industries in the Union Territory, next to agriculture. It is a source of livelihood for thousands of people.

Pondicherry State Weaver Cooperative Society [PONTEX], Pondicherry Cooperative Handloom Export Development Project [PONFAB], 14 primary Weaver Cooperative Societies and one Pondicherry Cooperative Textile Processing Society Ltd. are functioning at present. Two Cooperative Spinning Mills one at Puducherry and the other at Karaikal in the name of the Pondicherry Cooperative Spinning Mills(SPINCO) and the Jayaprakash Narayan Cooperative Spinning Mills(JPCOSPIN) are taking care in supplying the yarn to the Handloom Weavers through the 14 Primary Weaver Cooperatives including PONFAB, apart from sales in the outside market.

Handloom development Programmes aim at strengthening the structure of Weaver Cooperative Societies, improving the quality of Handloom fabrics, modernization of the handloom, up gradation of the weaving skills of the craftsmen and creation of more processing facilities. Financial assistance in the form of Grant-in-aid, Share Capital and Loans & Advances are extended to the Handloom Cooperatives and Spinning Mills for modernisation.

ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2009-10

Share Capital, Grant-in-aid, loands and advances were released to 14 Weavers Primary Co-operative Soceties and two Co-operative Spinning Mills at Puducherry and Karaikal.

LIKELY ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2010-11

PATTERN OF ASSISTANCE

The Pattern of assistance in relation to assistance to societies covered under the Handloom Sector remains same as it is from 2008 -09 and the modification/addition in the pattern of assistance are as follows:-

A) HANDLOOM DEVELOPMENT SCHEME:

Production incentive to weavers:

An incentive of 25% on the production value Handloom Goods made during the previous year subject to a maximum of ₹ 7,500/- per individual member of Weavers Cooperative Societies will be paid as Government assistance. (Change in Pattern).

B) HANDLOOM WEAVERS WELFARE SCHEME:

Assistance for training of weavers and appraisers:

In order to bring more persons to the weaving profession, training will be given by the Pondicherry State Weavers Coop. Society for 2 months to the Weavers, Appraisers and other allied workers with the grant of financial assistance as detailed below:
