

ROAD TRANSPORT

TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT

In order to provide transparent and quick services to the public, the Transport Department has computerized its activities in all the four regions. This Department has introduced the system of obtaining pollution test to the vehicles with latest techniques, which is environment-friendly. It has been proposed to introduce a new scheme of laying new railway line between Tindivanam and Cuddalore via Puducherry by releasing State Share contribution to the Southern Railway. The department has proposed to strengthen the revenue collection machinery by setting up of check-posts at all the entry point to the U.T. of Puducherry. Initially, it has been proposed to set-up three Check-posts in Puducherry region and one in Karaikal region, for which, proposal will be sent to Government for creation of sufficient posts in Technical and Ministerial cadres. Enforcement activities have been intensified by the department with a view to proper and effective implementation of provisions under Motor Vehicles Act and Rules. Road Safety Cell of the Transport Department has conducted various programmes, seminars and road-safety week, etc. to create awareness among the general public. It has been proposed to introduce the Mass Rapid Transport System (MRTS), so as to regulate the prevailing traffic conditions in Puducherry.

ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2009-10 :

- Road Safety awareness week were celebrated in all the four regions.
- Share Capital assistance was released to Pondicherry Road Transport Corporation to strengthen the corporation.
- 51,798 Nos. of vehicles have been registered during the year 2009-10.
- 21,148 Nos. of Driving Licenses issued during the year:
- An amount of ₹ 34.76 crores have been collected as fees for registration and driving license and road taxes.

LIKELY ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2010-11

- Setting-up of Check-posts at Kalapet, Madagadipet and Kanniyakoil in Puducherry Region and at Ambagarathur in Karaikal Region.

- Share capital assistance will be released to Puducherry Road Transport Corporation.
- State share will be released to Southern Railways for laying new railway lines between Tindivanam and Cuddalore via Puducherry.
- Setting up of Transport Complex at Karaikal.
- The existing revenue collection machinery will be strengthened.

PROPOSED TARGETS FOR 2011-12

- Establishment of Transport Complex at Karaikal which will have the Transport Department Automobile Workshop, Vehicle Testing Yard, Fuel Bunk and a Model Part.
- Setting-up of Network Security Moving Camera in and around the places of Transport Department which will watch the ongoing works and movements of the general public and others.
- Introduction of Smart Card – In order to provide effective service through latest technology, it is proposed to issue Smart Card for vehicles Registration and Driving Licenses along with the allied Transport Customer Care Services.
- To introduce the system of High Security Registration Plate (HSRP) for the vehicles in order to comply with the directions of Government of India.
- The existing revenue collection machinery will be strengthened.

GOVERNMENT AUTOMOBILE WORKSHOP

A Motor Vehicle Driving Training Institute is functioning in Puducherry and training is imparted to unemployed youth in driving Light Motor Vehicles and Heavy Motor Vehicles. A similar Institute is also functioning in Karaikal region. Refresher courses for Govt. Drivers are also conducted for updating their knowledge in maintenance & skill safe driving. One Emission Control Test Station each at Govt. Automobile Workshop, Puducherry and Karaikal are being set up to cater to the needs of the Govt. vehicles as well as that of the public.

Repairs, supply of fuel, lubricants, etc are done to all vehicles, agriculture machineries equipments etc. belonging to Government and Quasi Government agencies. A similar mini workshop fuelling station and a service station are also functioning in the outlying region at Karaikal. Practical in-plant and training under the Apprentices Act is given to unemployed I.T.I holders, Diploma Holders and Graduate Engineers, both in the field of Engineering and commercial practices to abreast their knowledge and skill in the respective fields.

ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2009-10

- The Motor Vehicle Driving Training Institute has provided 56 Nos. of LMV and 33 Nos. of HMV.
- Purchase of new version Computer and Printers and replacement.

LIKELY ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2010-11

- It is proposed to give training to 215 Nos. of LMV and 75 Nos. of HMV
- Purchase of new version Computer and Printers

PROPOSED TARGETS FOR 2011-12:

- The Motor Vehicle Driving Training Institute will give training to 215 Nos. of LMV & 100 Nos. of HMV
- Purchase of computer furniture
- Purchase of Machinery & Equipments
