ANIMAL HUSBANDRY

The broad objectives are:

- (i) to safeguard the health of all farm animals and to sustain and further improve their productivity to generate income and employment particularly in rural areas.
- (ii) to sustain the livestock health and to protect the genetic potential ultimately aiming to improve the milk production.
- (iii) to have a higher level of technical and administrative set up.
- (iv) training / extensive education about the latest technical know-how in rearing livestock, feeding, breeding, management and disease control.
- (v) to encourage backyard poultry production for egg and meat for which various poultry were supplied to the farmers at subsidized cost.
- (vi) under backyard egg production layer pullets are supplied at free of cost to BPL farmers.

ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2009-10

- ➤ The milk production was 45811 MTs.
- > 1000 BPL farmers were given milch animals @ 75% subsidy (₹9000/- per animal per beneficiary)
- Cattle feed subsidy to milch animal were given to farmers @ ₹2/- per Kg for milch animals; @ ₹3/- per kg for pregnant animals and @ ₹4.50 per kg for heifer calves.
- 435 SC beneficiaries were provided assistance by granting 75% subsidy for starting mini dairy units.
- 14 beneficiaries were given 75% subsidy for setting up of Rabbit and Japanese quil unit.
- 230 unemployed SC youth were given assistance for purchase of Sheep/Goat (25+1) at 75% subsidy.
- 350 SC BPL beneficiaries were given 75% subsidy for purchase of Sheep/Goat unit (5+1)
- > 211 SC agricultural labourers were given 25% subsidy to a maximum of ₹ 3,000/- for construction of cattle shed.

- > 125 SC BPL farmers were given @ ₹ 12,000/- per beneficiaries for purchase of cross breed milch buffalo.
- > 660 SC BPL farmers were given 75% subsidy to a maximum of ₹ 9,000/- per beneficiaries for purchase of single milch cow.

LIKELY ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2010-11

- ▶ milk production is increased to 46,000 MTs.
- distribution of milch cow @ 75% subsidy to 6000 general farmers and 844 SC BPL farmers is targeted.
- feed subsidy for purchase of cattle feed to milch animals and calf feed to heifer calves are issued at 75% subsidy.
- > 75% subsidy is provided to 400 BPL farmers for purchase of Sheep/Goat unit (5+1).
- > 5000 Turkey poultry are likely to be distributed to BPL farmers at subsidized cost.
- 30,000 dual purpose breed of poultry to be distributed to farmers @ 50% subsidy for backyard egg and meat production.
- 3,000 BPL farmers are to be distributed with a unit 5 nos. of layer pullets free of cost for egg production.

PROPOSED TARGETS FOR 2011-12:

- milk production is estimated to 47,000 MTs.
- ▶ feed subsidy @ 75% is to be given for milch animal and heifer calves.
- 75% subsidy is to be given to BPL farmers for purchase of milch animal, (5+1) goat/sheep unit (SCP).
- 6 week Turkey poultry and dual purpose poultry are to be distributed to farmers
 @50% subsidy.
- 3000 BPL farmers will be distributed with 18 week layer pullets for backyard egg production.
- 30,000 dual purpose breed of poultry to be distributed to farmers @ 50% subsidy for backyard egg and meat production.
