EDUCATION

SCHOOL EDUCATION

Education plays a vital role in the economic, social and cultural development of a country. Besides moulding character and values of the citizen, the overall growth of the country depends on educational growth. Education is the basic prerequisite to build a just, equitable society and tool for the development of the individual and the nation. The vision is to offer quality education aiming an all round development from Primary to Higher Secondary level. In so far as the Union territory of Puducherry is concerned education has been placed at a higher pedestal.

Status on the Literacy position in the UT of Puducherry

As per 2001 census, the literacy rate of Union Territory of Puducherry is 81.23% as against the National average of 65.38%. This Union Territory has been placed under category-IV having literacy rate of 75% and above and is in the 7th place in the ranking of literacy rate among all State/union Territories. The task before the Union Territory is to achieve 100% literacy rate by 2012. In order to ensure universal access to primary education, The Puducherry Compulsory Education Act 2000 was published on 24.10.2001. The region wise literacy rate is given below:

Elementary Education

There are 301 Primary schools and 121 Middle schools (both Govt. / Govt. aided and private schools are functioning. As per National norms 1 Primary school for 1 km radius should be available. All the 437 habitations in the Union Territory are provided with access to Primary schools within 1 km distance. The dropout in Primary is Nil as per National

survey. In Education development Index this U.T ranks second (2006-07) in Primary and Upper Primary schooling. The teacher pupil ratio is 1:25 (National norms 1:32).

Secondary Education

There are 168 High Schools and 98 Higher Secondary Schools (both Govt / Govt-aided and private schools). In this Union Territory every student passing 10th Std is assured of a seat in the Hr. Sec. Classes. Every Higher Secondary school is provided with a lab of 20 computers and an LCD projector. To ensure retention and reduce dropout in secondary and Higher Secondary level,. free supply of uniform, text books, note books, footwear, free Mid-day meals and breakfast have been extended upto XII standard in Govt. / Govt – aided schools. The total student strength in secondary and Higher secondary class is 67048 which includes 34095 girl students. The District Institute of Education & Training (DIET) and the State Training Centre (STC) take care of in-service training to teachers.

Cash award of ₹ 1 lakhs will be presented to Govt. Schools which achieve 100% result in urban areas and 90% result in rural areas. Mementoes will be presented to the teachers who achieve 100% result in their subjects in the Public Examination results. Cash awards will be presented to the National Talent Search Examination Toppers each Rs.5000/-who are selected in the NTS examination conducted by Directorate of School Education.

Various welfare measures provided for the benefit of School Children

The weaker section of the society still find it difficult to send their children as they are unable to cope up with the resulting burden of expenditure. In order to attract students to the schools and to encourage them to continue their studies without dropouts, text books, uniforms, foot wears, stationeries are freely supplied to the school children.

In addition, this administration has also launched the students 'Bus Pass Scheme' for promoting school to reduce burden of the transport difficulties of the school going children.

Adult Education

In order to achieve total literacy and to cover 1,00,000 neo-literates in the age group 14-45 in which women constitute major chunk, a new programme called Kamarajar Literacy Mission will be initiated in accordance with the observations made by His Excellency the President of India during the visit to Puducherry on 01.11.2004.

Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan

Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan, the Universalisation of Elementary Education in a mission mode, was launched in Puducherry in 2003. The scheme aims to provide quality elementary education for all children in the age group 6-14 by 2010 and to bridge the social, regional and gender gaps.

To initiate the community as the owners of Education system, a Village Education Committee for each school is formed involving members of the community.

The Village Education Committee (VEC) is entrusted with the responsibility to monitor and to spend the amount given by Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan to the schools by adhering to the usual procedure and norms.

The capacities of the teachers are updated by organizing series of training courses to the teachers, most of the teachers are trained around 5 to 7 days per year against the norm of 20 days. The 86th Constitution Amendment Act 2002 makes Education a fundamental right for all children in the age group of 6-14 years. To ensure the fundamental right, mainstreaming of out of school children and children with special needs is the main target of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan which is achieved by adopting three strategies, enrolment drive, universalizing physical access and strategies for other out of school children in Puducherry. The steps adopted for enrolling the out of school children are by opening alternative and innovative schools. One such school, which is successful, is the school opened at Narikuravur habitations which has enrolled 53 children, who would otherwise be out of school children. A residential bridge camp started at Yanam enrolling 106 students is also another intervention for tackling the problems of seasonal migrants.

Inclusive education is a developmental approach seeking to address the learning needs of all children. It is a dynamic process to enable, enhance and strengthen the education systems and methodologies to meet the needs of children with disabilities. Through various activities like identification, assessing, providing assistive device, mobilizing resource material, providing home based learning and financing for corrective surgeries this U.T Administration attempt to acknowledge that "Given an opportunity All children can Learn".

Realizing the importance and impact of Pre Primary Education on Primary Education, the Government of Puducherry started Pre Primary classes in all Government Primary Schools. Puducherry is unique in having Pre Primary classes in all Government Primary Schools where specially trained Pre – Primary teachers are engaged under SSA for handling KG classes. To promote the girls' enrolment in Puducherry, SSA has implemented vocational skill development programme in schools to empower girl children. Besides, a counseling programme for adolescent girls have been running successfully to overcome their stress and strain encountered in their adolescent period by engaging trained women teachers as counseling assistants.

Quality Initiatives:

- i. The Activity Based Learning is introduced in all Tamil Medium Schools
- ii. The Active Learning Methodology has been introduced in all Upper Primary classes for the subject Science and Social Studies.
- iii. An innovative model of Computer Aided Learning is being evolved and introduced in 40 schools as a first step. If this model is successful, it will be introduced in all other schools. This model is being implemented along with the convergence of Azim Premji Foundation
- iv. An innovative model of teaching maths through Computer Aided Learning has been introduced in all Upper Primary Sections.

Sports and Youth Services

The main objective of this sports wing is to develop the physical health of the students by way of conducting Annual Sports day, distribution of prozes medals, cash awards, certificates etc. For the development of sports the infrastructure available includes Indira Gandhi Stadium Complex at Uppalam with facilities like Astro – turf Hockey field, Tennis play Court, Cricket training pitch, Volley ball court, Hand ball court, Kho-Kho & Kabaddi courts and Rajiv Gandhi Indoor Stadium. The important activities are organization of Zonal level school games (8 Zones), Coaching camps prior to state school games, 15 days specialized training prior to participation in State School Games, State School Games Championship Programme, Participation in National School Games Championship, State level Children's rally, Independence Day / Republic Day parade arrangements and cultural programme, Coaching programme for selected students to participate in National Competitions.

Pondicherry State Sports Council

An autonomous body for the development of sports activities among the youth. The State Sports Associations are recognized by the Pondicherry State Sports Council. The Sports council is funded by the Govt. by way of Grant-in-aid every year to carry out its functions. 23 number of Association have been recognized. Funding for National and Zonal Championship participation and cash award to winners of international and National level sports events.

Rajiv Gandhi School of Sports

An autonomous institution fully funded by Government. 100 young student (6th to 12th) having special sports skill are selected and accommodated in the Rajiv Gandhi School of Sports and continue to get the special coaching in the games like Football, Hockey, Volleyball, Athletic and Badminton. The students pursue their studies in the urban area schools. Nutritional food at `.80/- per day per student is spent. This School prepares the students for participation in National competitions. 15 acres of land has been allotted in Kalapet revenue village for the construction of building for Rajiv Gandhi School of Sports.

ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2009-10

- Govt. schools are provided with internet facilities (Broad Band) and the same are connected with World Wide Web (WWW). These facilities are provided in 244 Govt. Primary Schools and 64 Govt. High Schools in all the four regions of the U.T. of Puducherry.
- In 21 Govt. schools Satellite Interactive Terminals (SIT) were installed with the financial assistance from ISRO/Department of Information Technology and a studio especially for UT of Puducherry is functioning in SSA office, Education Department with dedicated connection to Anna University.
- New method of Activity Based Learning (ABL) was introduced in all Primary schools.
- I1 top scorers in the National Talent Search Examination conducted by the Directorate of School Education were given cash award of ₹ 60,000/-
- State Level Science Exhibition was conducted at Puducherry and Karaikal.
- Students from UT of Puducherry have participated in Southern Zonal Science Exhibition.
- 5 Students had won the Prizes in Skating events in the Ntional School level Sports Competition.

- Education Scholarship at the rate of ₹ 600/- each was given to 12 Outstanding Sports students and Cash award of ₹ 500/- each was given to 5 outstanding sports youths every year.
- Scholarships were given to 17563 OEBC students.
- Incentive award were given to 1569 students of poor and weaker section of the Society.
- Trained Graduate Teachers (Tamil) were given in-service Refreshment Training.
- Graduate Teacher (Science & Social) were given in service Training in Active Learning Methodology.
- Land was acquired for Kavignar Vanidasanar High School, Selliamedu, S.R.Subramaniyam Govt. High School, Saram and Govt. Primary School Navarkulam, at a cost of ₹ 296.00lakhs, ₹ 526.20lakhs and ₹ 97.22lakhs respectively.

- The salary of Pre Primary School Teachers is increased from `.5000/- to `.6000/- p.m.
- Approval for establishing Kendriya Vidyalaya in Karaikal has been received and the admissions have been stated from the academic year 2010-11 onwards.
- ➤ A number of 122 students from various category of schools UT of Puducherry participated in the State Level Exhibition under INSPIRE Award programme, to inspire the student community for taking science as a career opportunity, organized by the Directorate of School Education in collaboration with the Ministry of Science and

Technology, New Delhi on 21st to 23rd July 2010, of then 5 students are selected for National Level Exhibition.

- ➢ 63 class rooms constructed under SSA Scheme in Karaikal District was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Union Minister for Human Resource Development.
- In Puducherry 125 class rooms have been constructed and are nearing completion under SSA Scheme.
- Construction of new Building in GHS at Alankuppam and GHSS Nonankuppam has been completed and inaugurated. GHS Arumpathapuram completed and to be inaugurated shortly.
- Foundation stone for renovation of Rajiv Gandhi Indoor Stadium at a cost of Rs.7.05 crore was laid.
- Puducherry State Sports Council, given the Cash Awards for an amount of 1.66 Crore to 168 meritorious sports persons for the achievements of sports in Inter-National, National and Zonal levels.

- In order to cover 99,000 illiterate in the age group 14-35 Kamarajar Literacy Mission will be started under Adult Education Programme.
- The Rastriya Madhyamik Siksha Abhiyan (RMSA) will be implemented with state contribution.
- Education scholarship at the rate of `.600/- cash will be given to 12 outstanding sports students and cash award of `.500/- each will be given to 5 outstanding sports youths this year.
- Cash award of ₹.1.00 lakhs will be presented to Govt. Schools which achieve 100% result in urban areas and 90% result in rural areas.

STRATEGIES PROPOSED AND POLICY FOCUSSED FOR 2011-12

➤ To improve quality and standard of Education and further improvement in literacy rate, it is proposed for strengthening of computer education, provision of required infrastructure like additional classrooms, toilet, drinking water supply, benches / desks etc., to create congenial atmosphere. Land will be acquired for construction of pucca building for schools running in rented building.

- For providing educational infrastructure facilities at various schools, loan assistance will be availed under RIDF from NABARD.
- Under Rashtriya Madhamik Shiksha Abhiyan it is proposed to cover 70 High School and 48 Higher Secondary Schools by releasing grants for construction of additional classrooms, laboratory and library room.
- Under Information Communication Technology scheme, each school will be provided with 10 computers, printer, scanner, web camera and other peripherals. The pattern of funding for the above scheme will be 75% : 25%.
- Pass percentage in Govt. Schools especially in rural areas will be improved through special coaching for slow learners and filling up of vacant teaching posts and creation of new posts due to upgradation of schools and opening of additional sections.
- All schools will be provided with Fire Fighting equipments.
- Kamarajar Literacy Mission will be started to cover 99,000 illiterates in the age group 14-35.
- Based on necessity and requirement, Primary Schools, Middle Schools and High Schools will be upgraded.

HIGHER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION

The Directorate of Higher & Technical Education was established by bifurcating the erstwhile Directorate of Education for dealing with the matters pertaining to the Higher Education. Government of Puducherry, to impart quality higher education has established various colleges in the Government sector and also under various Societies. Apart from this, private initiative in the field of higher education also being encouraged by this Government by providing No Objection Certificate for Private Managements to start Arts & Science Colleges and Professional Colleges.

There are seven Government Arts & Science Colleges in the U.T. of Puducherry, they are, Bharathidasan Govt. College for Women, Tagore Arts College, Kanchi Mamunivar Centre for Post Graduate Studies in Puducherry Region, Avvaiyar Govt. College for Women, Arignar Anna Govt. Arts College in Karaikal Region, Mahatma Gandhi Govt. Arts College in Mahe Region and Dr. S.R.K. Govt. Arts College in Yanam Region.

There are four Arts & Science Colleges and one B.Ed. Colleges under the Pondicherry Society for Higher Education (PONSHE) as follows :

- i) Perunthalaivar Kamarajar College of Education, Karaikal
- ii) Indira Gandhi College of Arts & Science, Puducherry.
- iii) Perunthalaivar Kamarajar Govt. Arts College, Kalitheerthalkuppam,Puducherry
- iv) Rajiv Gandhi Arts College, Thavalakuppam, Puducherry.
- v) Kasthurba College for Women, Villianur, Puducherry

These colleges are mainly promoted to offer job oriented courses and also to provide quality education for the rural population, courses like B.Sc.(Bio-Technology), B.Sc.(Computer Science), B.Sc (Statistics) and B.A., (Foreign Trade) and B.Sc.(Microbiology) B.B.A. (Tourism and Travel Management), B.A. (Social Work) are offered in the above said colleges.

As far as Professional Colleges are concerned, Pondicherry Engineering College is one of the premiers Institution offering various B.Tech. & M.Tech. Courses. An Engineering College has been started at Karaikal during the academic year 2007-08.

To promote Post Matric Technical Education, the Government has established a Pondicherry Institute of Post Matric Technical Education Society (PIPMATE) which runs five Polytechnic Colleges apart from that there is one Government Polytechnic viz. Mothilal Nehru Government Polytechnic located at Lawspet, Puducherry

Four Polytechnic Colleges run by PIPMATE Society are:

- 1. Women Polytechnic College, Puducherry
- 2. Karaikal Polytechnic College, Karaikal
- 3. Indira Gandhi Polytechnic College, Mahe
- 4. Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Polytechnic College, Yanam.
- 5. Women Polytechnic College, Karaikal.

The University Grants Commission has accorded approval for the conferment of autonomous status to Bharathidasan Govt. College for Women, Puducherry & Kanchimamunivar Centre for PG studies, Puducherry. Action is being taken to obtain Autonomous status to other Govt. Colleges.

ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2009-10:

- Permanent Affiliation has been obtained for Indira Gandhi College of Arts & Science, Puducherry from Pondicherry University.
- Shift system has been introduced in Karaikal Polytechnic College and the student's enrollment for the year 2009-10 was doubled from 410 to 820.
- Community Polytechnic Scheme has been introduced in Karaikal
- 10% of seats increased in all Govt. / Govt. run society Arts & Science Colleges and more no. of students got admission in 2009-10.
- A Community College has been started in the Campus of Karaikal Polytechnic, Karaikal to offer job oriented, work related, skill based and life-coping education mainly for the drop-out students from the schools in the Karaikal Region.
- Language Lab, Personality Development Programme and Soft skill development including Spoken English Classes, Computer literacy programmes, special coaching classes are taken up exclusively for SC students studying in the colleges functioning under PONSHE, PIPMATE & PEC, PKIET under "Scheduled Caste Sub-Plan"

ART AND CULTURE

The Union Territory of Puducherry, the erstwhile French colony has many legacies of art & culture with a rich heritage. Separate Directorate for Art and Culture has been established in order to develop the arts, literature, political legacies and remembrance of great poets. Maintenance of Romain Rolland Library and Public Branch Libraries (80 Nos.), Bharathiar Museum, Bharathidasan Museum, Subbaiah Museum, Toy Museum, French, Kizhour and Puducherry Museums and autonomous institutions like Bharathiar Palkalaikoodam and Pondicherry Institute of Linguistics Culture come under the purview of the Department of Art & Culture. Financial assistance are given to the artistes distinguished in letters / performing visual arts etc., and to the tamil scholars who are in indigent circumstances to uplift the economic condition of their life.

The Art and Culture Department is preserving the records/publications and strengthening the archives. Grant–in-aid are released to Bharathiar Palkalaikoodam, Pondicherry Institute of Linguistic and Culture and M/s.INTACH, Pudhucherry every year for the overall development of Art and Cultural activities of the Puducherry.

Voluntary Cultural organisation are assisted financially and fellowship grants provided to the research scholars for pursuing higher studies in the filed of Art and Culture. Grant of Financial assistance for the publication of Manuscripts and for making Documentary Film on the life History of renowned Poets/Freedom fighters. Establishment of Centre for Performing Arts is under process.

Along with the above objectives the Department looks after the conducting of Birth and Death Anniversaries of various Leaders, Poets and Freedom Fighters.

ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2009-10

- Financial assistance to voluntary cultural troupes are given to those who perform Open Air Cultural programmes like Therukoothu, Puppetry, Karagattam etc.
