DAIRY DEVELOPEMNT

The main objectives are:

- (i) to increase milk production by improving the productivity of milch cows, thereby providing remunerative prices to the farmers.
- (ii) to maintain an effective supply system of milk and milk products at reasonable price for the consumers.
- (iii) to provide subsidiary occupation to farmers to supplement their income and improve their standard of living.

To attain the above objectives, Primary Cooperative Milk Producers' Societies have been organized and which have taken over the responsibility of the collection of milk from member producer. 101 Primary Cooperative milk producers societies in Puducherry region, are supplying milk by affiliating them with Pondicherry Cooperative Milk Producers' Union Ltd., and 19 primary cooperative milk producers' societies in the Karaikal region are supplying milk to the Karaikal Cooperative Milk Producers' Union Ltd,. Karaikal and one primary cooperative milk producers' society in Yanam region is supplying milk to the Govt. Hostels, Hospitals etc.,

➤ A sum of ₹ 596.19 lakhs, was green in the form of Grant-in-aid to the Pondicherry Cooperative Milk Producers' Union, Karaikal Cooperative Milk Producers' Union and 38 Primary Dairy Cooperatives
