WELFARE OF SCHEDULED CASTES

Under the Sector Welfare of Scheduled Castes, Adi Dravidar Welfare Department is implementing various innovative schemes for the welfare of SC community under the following two major categories.

- 1. Schemes for educational improvements, training self-employment to the scheduled castes population.
- 2. Schemes for social and economic development of scheduled caste population.

During the Tenth Plan (2002-2007), 12,067 Students were benefited by pre-metric Scholarship. Opportunity cost was paid to 37,552 parents of SC students. Free clothing items were supplied to 7,19,072 SC people. 372 free house site pattas were distributed to homeless SC people. Financial Assistance was released to 120 inter-caste married couples and 3700 pregnant and lactating mothers. House Construction subsidy was given to 800 homeless SC people. Grant-in-aid was released to local bodies for taking up 81 civic works. 28 boys and girls hostels are functioning in all the three regions and 12,500 students were benefited.

The SC people who are not in a position to purchase minimum clothing are supplied with one sari and a blouse to a female person and a lunge with a shirt to a male person who attained the age of 18 years every year. Under this scheme 1,57,000 SC people were benefited. An amount of ₹15,000/- as Financial Assistance is granted to the parents of SC brides to perform marriage and the pregnant and Lactating mother are granted ₹6000/- in order to extend the financial assistance to poor SC women, under this scheme 1364 SC woman were benefited.

An amount of ₹2 lakh as House Construction Subsidy was given to 1798 homeless SC people, Grant-in-aid was released to local bodies for taking up 65 civic works. In 28 boys and girls hostels are functioning in all the three regions and 2453 students are availing benefits.

Presently 12 Hostels are running in private buildings. Necessary proposal was sent to Government of India to avail fund under CSS for construction of three more new hostels so that all the hostels will run in Government buildings.

During the Annual Plan 2009-10, 8374 SC students were awarded pre-matric Scholarship, 6420 SC girls students were benefited by opportunity cost. 3736 SC students were awarded Post-matric scholarship. 1,92,200 SC people were given free clothing items. 1917 homeless SC families were given subsidy for construction of house. 2479 SC Poor brides, pregnant and lactating women and SC patient suffering from prolonged disease were benefited. 2955 SC students were provided with hostel facilities. Grant-in-aid was given to Local Bodies to take up 116 civic works.

From 1St April 2007 onwards the Scheduled Caste Sub-Plan subject is dealt in this Department vide G.O. Ms.No.1/PRD/2007 dt.05.02.2007. It is proposed to create various Technical and Ministerial Post for the Scheduled Caste Sub-Plan Cell. ₹20,000/- is being given to each SC family for construction of toilet in their house, it is also proposed to conduct evening coaching classes at 250 SC colonies to cover 10,000 SC students. The PTKFAS of the Department of Higher & Technical Education has been adopted and the same is implemented in this Department from the financial year 2008-09 onwards for SC students who are sponsored by the CENTAC and pursuing Professional courses. A separate scholarship scheme under the name of Dr. Ambedkar Financial Assistance is also proposed to implement by replacing the PTKFAS. This department has availed first installement of negotiated loan for an amount of ₹15.00 crores from HUDCO for construction of Housing Tenaments in the newly distributed Housing colonies to SC families.

PADCO a public sector corporation is extending financial assistance for setting up of trade Industries so as to create self-employments and to improve training for the development of skill among SC educated and un-employed youths to enable them to lead a decent life.

ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2009-10 :

- > 923 SC students are awarded Pre-metric Scholarship.
- > 3736 SC students are awarded Post-Metric scholarship.
- Under PADCO 840 persons were benefitted.
- ➢ 6420 SC girls students were benefited by opportunity cost.
- ▶ Nearly 192200 SC people are given free clothing items.
- Covered 2479 poor SC brides, pregnant and lactating women were benefited.
- > 11 students were benefitted under Re-imbursement of Tuition fees.

Financial Assistance to undergo professional courses sponsored by CENTAC were given to 273 students.

LIKELY ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2010-11:

- About 7900 SC girls students will be benefited under the scheme Opportunity Cost.
- About, 195000 SC beneficiaries will be covered under the scheme, "Free supply of clothing items".
- Under the scheme of purchase, distribution and development of house sites 600 families are proposed to be covered, for which land acquisition process is under anvil.
- > Under PADCO 890 persons are to be benefitted.
- Engineering Cell for construction and effective maintenance of Hostel and Survey Wing has been setup for attending Land Acquisition work.
- Proposed to cover 2500 persons under the scheme of financial assistance to the parent of poor SC brides, pregnant & lactating women and SC patients suffering from prolonged diseases.
- About 1100 students under Pre-matric scholarship and 3750 students under Postmatric scholarship will be benefited.
- > 20 students are to be benefitted under Re-imbursement of Tuition fees.
- > 1250 SC students would be covered under coaching and allied facilities.
- > Land acquired for one Residential School at Puducherry Region.
- Financial Assistance to undergo professional courses sponsored by CENTAC will be given to 300 students.
- > Adi Dravidar Welfare will be strengthened by creating required posts.
- > Setting up of Residential School under Additional Central Assistance.

PROPOSED TARGETS FOR 2011-12:

- Nearly, 8295 SC girls students will be benefited under the scheme Opportunity Cost.
- About, 197200 SC beneficiaries will be covered under the scheme, "Free supply of clothing items".

- Under the scheme of purchase, distribution and development of house sites 700 families are proposed to be covered, for which land acquisition process is under anvil.
- ➤ Under PADCO 940 persons to be benefitted.
- Proposed to cover 2600 persons under the scheme of financial assistance to the parent of poor SC brides, pregnant & lactating women and SC patients suffering from prolonged diseases.
- About 1155 students under Pre-matric scholarship & 4000 students under Postmetric scholarship will be benefited.
- > 20 students are to be benefitted under Re-imbursement of Tuition fees.
- > Proposed for one Residential School at Karaikal Region.
- > 1500 SC students will be covered under the scheme Coaching & Allied facilities.
- Financial Assistance to undergo professional courses sponsored by CENTAC will be given to 400 students
- Setting up of Residential School.
- > Adi Dravidar Welfare will be strengthened by creating the following posts:
