RURAL DEVELOPMENT

LOCAL ADMINISTRATION

Under this sector an amount of ₹5048.00 lakhs have been earmarked for the MLA's / Councillors Local Area Development Scheme for the implementation of the works proposed by the MLA's / Councillors will be executed viz. improvements of roads, construction of school buildings, Community Hall, Library Block, improvement to Markets as suggested by the MLAs. An amount of ₹300.00 lakhs has been earmarked to issue matching grant to Commune Panchayats in Puducherry and Karaikal region to meet the operational cost of water supply system and Rural electrification facilities. An amount of ₹301.80 lakhs has been provided for the construction of Panchayat building-cum-community centre and market in Puducherry and Karaikal Region. An amount of ₹202.88 lakhs has been provided for the implementation of the scheme revival of burial ground and ₹130.00 lakhs has been earmarked for the Perunthalaivar Kamarajar Village Renaissance Scheme. To give financial assistance to weaker Commune Panchayats an amount of ₹.60.00 lakhs has been earmarked as untied fund and ₹98.00 lakhs has been earmarked to issue all the village panchayats of Puducherry and Karaikal region. For the Construction of Village Panchayat offices in Puducherry and Karaikal Region an amount of ₹200.00lakhs has been earmarked.

Community Development Programme

Rural Development Programme is to uplift the standard of living among the rural people and to bring forth-general awareness in the modern technology in the field of Education etc. Health awareness programme, rural employment programmes and housing programme are also implemented. Apart from the above, the following activities such as:

- Purchase and distributions of Sports Articles/ to Mahila/Yuvak Mandals.
- Conduct of health/naturopathy camps.
- Purchase distribution and maintenance of community TV sets
- Payment of honorarium to the TV Caretakers @ ₹300/- per month.
- Maintenance Gardens under Applied Nutrition Programmes

Promotion and Strengthening of Mahila/Yuvak Mandals:

The objective of the programme is to encourage rural women and youths to organise themselves into groups/Association to enable them to carry on socio-economic and Community Development activities such as running of Balwadis, Adult Education Centres, to get them involved in Poverty alleviation programmes and Self Employment Programmes to create and provide them infrastructure facilities to spend their leisure time in a purposeful manner including development of play field/children's park in rural areas and to give them incentive awards for the best Women and Youth /Associations.

DRDA

The object of this rural development programmes are to bring the BPL above the poverty line. This responsibility has been broadly classified in to two heads namely, (i) creation of employment opportunities and (ii) providing opportunities for income generating activities. The next responsibility is provision of basic necessity of human survival i.e., Housing. Healthy Habitation goes along with that. All these has been achieved by implementing the schemes viz., NREGA, SGSY, IAY & TSC.

Employment opportunities are being created under Mahathma Ghandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme and the State Government has to provide 100 days of wage employment in a year to every rural household whose adult members are willing to do unskilled manual work. The scheme launched in the U.T. of Puducherry w.e.f. 1.4.2008.

The preparative activities like training, Job card & registers printing, Issue of Job cards, Bank Accounts opening and deployment of dedicated key personnel were undertaken during 2008-09. The scope of this scheme and role of PRI functionaries has been ascertained. Gradually the Act is being enforced in all 98 Gram Panchayats of Arainkuppam, Villianur and rural area of Karaikal block in both the district of Pondicherry and Karaikal. Now the scheme is getting momentum in this U.T. As a result of effort, 74,411 individuals were registered from 60,780 household and they have been issued with Job Cards. The equal

number job cards holder have been provided with employment. No job cards holder is denied for work so far. The sufficient number of works were identified in all Gram Pancahays through their Gram Sabhas and estimated at amount of ₹ 3905.78 lakhs. Administrative approval is also been accorded for ready for execution.

In 2009-10, ₹793.00 lakhs was allocated by GOI, of which ₹459.93 lakhs was released. ₹ 718.97 lakhs was spent by generating of 9,05,878 mandays and 891 works were completed.

In view of the above progressive achievement under the MGNREGA, the GOI has sanctioned a Labour Budget for 2010-11 at an amount of ₹ 2247.00 lakhs to this U.T, ₹ 9.12 crores is released as first installment during June 2010. Within a span of five month ₹ 873.01 lakhs has been spent by this U.T under the scheme by generating of 10,49,788 mandays and 678 works were completed.

Since inception of the scheme, so far ₹1632.41 lakhs has been spent under MGNREGA by generating of 21.23 lakhs manadys and 1910 works were completed In the implementation of MGNREGA, this U.T stands in first position among the other State at nation level in respect of 96.74% of work completion and payments are being made to MGNREGA beneficiaries through their Bank

The year wise performance and allocation of funds by GOI is increased at every year under MGNREGA (ie. from ₹419.44 lakhs to ₹2247.00 lakhs) based on our progressive achievements Under the State purview, as per Sec.22 of NREGA,2005, the UT shall meet the cost of ⊕i) cost of Unemployment allowance;(ii)1/4th of the material cost of the scheme & (iii) Administrative expenses of State Employment Guarantee Council

Under the self employment scheme, National Rural Livelihood Mission(NRLM) is being introduced in the UT during 2010-11, which will be implemented in full swing in 2011-12 in accordance with GOI policy, replacing the erstwhile SGSY (Swarnjayanthi Gram swarozgar Yojana) scheme. However, SGSY will continue for some time till NRLM is fully imp[lamented in the UT.
