SCHOOL EDUCATION

Status on the Literacy position in the UT of Puducherry

As per 2011 census, the literacy rate of Union Territory of Puducherry is 86.55%, of which male literacy is 92.12% and female literacy rate is 81.22%. The task before the Union Territory is to achieve 100% literacy rate during the 12th Five Year Plan(2012-17). In order to achieve total literacy and to cover 1,00,000 neo-literates in the age group 14-45 in which women constitute major chunk, a new programme called Kamarajar Literacy Mission will be initiated during 2012-13.

Education plays a vital role in the economic, social and cultural development of a country. Besides moulding character and values of the citizen, the overall growth of the country depends on educational growth. Education is the basic prerequisite to build a just, equitable society and tool for the development of the individual and the nation. The vision is to offer quality education aiming an all round development from Primary to Higher Secondary level. In so far as the Union territory of Puducherry is concerned education has been placed at a higher pedestal.

Elementary Education

There are 300 Primary schools and 108 Middle schools (both Govt. / Govt. aided and private schools are functioning. As per National norms 1 Primary school for 1 km radius should be available. All the 437 habitations in the Union Territory are provided with access to Primary schools within 1 km distance. The dropout in Primary is Nil as per National Survey. In Education development Index this U.T ranks second (2006-07) in Primary and Upper Primary schooling. The teacher pupil ratio is 1:25 (National norms 1:32).

Secondary Education

There are 180 High Schools and 112 Higher Secondary Schools (both Govt. / Govt.aided and private schools). In this Union Territory every student passing 10th Std is assured of a seat in the Hr. Sec. Classes. Every Higher Secondary school is provided with a lab of 20 computers and an LCD projector. To ensure retention and reduce dropout in secondary and Higher Secondary level, free supply of uniform, text books, note books, footwear, free Midday meals and breakfast have been extended upto XII standard in Govt. / Govt – aided schools. The total student strength in secondary and Higher secondary class is 71233 which includes 36426 girl students. The District Institute of Education & Training (DIET) and the State Training Centre (STC) take care of in-service training to teachers. Cash award of $\overline{\mathbf{x}}1$ lakh are presented to Govt. Schools which achieve 100% result in urban areas and 90% result in rural areas and Mementoes are presented to the teachers who achieve 100% result in their subjects in the Public Examination results, in order to improve the quality of school education. Cash awards will be presented to the National Talent Search Examination Toppers each $\overline{\mathbf{x}}5000$ /- who are selected in the NTS examination conducted by Directorate of School Education.

Various welfare measures provided for the benefit of School Children

The weaker sections of the society still find it difficult to send their children as they are unable to cope up with the resulting burden of expenditure. In order to attract students to the schools and to encourage them to continue their studies without dropouts, text books, uniforms, foot wears, stationeries are freely supplied to the school children. In addition, this administration has also launched the students 'Bus Pass Scheme' to reduce burden of the transport difficulties of the school going children. It is proposed for free supply of school bags for school children from 1st to 8th Standard from the academic year 2012-13.

Right to Education

To implement the provisions of the Right to Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009, the Puducherry Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 has been notified vide G.O. Ms.No. 101 dt.24th October 2011.

Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan

Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan, the Universalisation of Elementary Education in a mission mode, was launched in Puducherry in 2003. The scheme aims to provide quality elementary education for all children in the age group 6-14 and to bridge the social, regional and gender gaps.

To initiate the community as the owners of Education system, a Village Education Committee for each school is formed involving members of the community. The Village Education Committee (VEC) is entrusted with the responsibility to monitor and to spend the amount given by Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan to the schools by adhering to the usual procedure and norms.

The capacities of the teachers are updated by organizing series of training courses to the teachers, most of the teachers are trained around 5 to 7 days per year against the norm of 20 days. The 86th Constitution Amendment Act 2002 makes Education a fundamental right for all children in the age group of 6-14 years. To ensure the fundamental right, mainstreaming of out of school children and children with special needs is the main target of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan which is achieved by adopting three strategies, enrolment drive, universalizing physical access and strategies for other out of school children in Puducherry. The steps adopted for enrolling the out of school children are by opening alternative and innovative schools. One such school, which is successful, is the school opened at Narikuravur habitations which has enrolled 53 children, who would otherwise be out of school children. A residential bridge camp started at Yanam enrolling 106 students is also another intervention for tackling the problems of seasonal migrants.

Inclusive education is a developmental approach seeking to address the learning needs of all children. It is a dynamic process to enable, enhance and strengthen the education systems and methodologies to meet the needs of children with disabilities. Through various activities like identification, assessing, providing assistive device, mobilizing resource material, providing home based learning and financing for corrective surgeries this U.T Administration attempt to acknowledge that "Given an opportunity All children can Learn".

Realizing the importance and impact of Pre Primary Education on Primary Education, the Government of Puducherry started Pre Primary classes in all Government Primary Schools. Puducherry is unique in having Pre Primary classes in all Government Primary Schools where specially trained Pre – Primary teachers are engaged under SSA for handling KG classes. To promote the girls'' enrolment in Puducherry, SSA has implemented vocational skill development programme in schools to empower girl children. Besides, a counseling programme for adolescent girls have been running successfully to overcome their stress and strain encountered in their adolescent period by engaging trained women teachers as counseling assistants.

Quality Initiatives:

- i. The Activity Based Learning is introduced in all Tamil Medium Schools
- ii. The Active Learning Methodology has been introduced in all Upper Primary classes for the subject Science and Social Studies.
- iii. An innovative model of Computer Aided Learning is being evolved and introduced in 40 schools as a first step. If this model is successful, it will be introduced in all other schools. This model is being implemented along with the convergence of Azim Premji Foundation
- iv. An innovative model of teaching maths through Computer Aided Learning has been introduced in all Upper Primary Sections.

Sports and Youth Services

The main objective of this sports wing is to develop the physical health of the students by way of conducting Annual Sports day, distribution of prizes medals, cash awards, certificates etc. For the development of sports the infrastructure available includes Indira Gandhi Stadium Complex at Uppalam with facilities like Astro – turf Hockey field, Tennis play Court, Cricket training pitch, Volley ball court, Hand ball court, Kho-Kho & Kabaddi courts and Rajiv Gandhi Indoor Stadium. The important activities are organization of Zonal level school games (8 Zones), Coaching camps prior to state school games, 15 days specialized training prior to participation in State School Games, State School Games Championship Programme, Participation in National School Games Championship, State level Children''s rally, Independence Day / Republic Day parade arrangements and cultural programme, Coaching programme for selected students to participate in National Competitions.

Pondicherry State Sports Council

An autonomous body for the development of sports activities among the youth. The State Sports Associations are recognized by the Pondicherry State Sports Council. The Sports council is funded by the Govt. by way of Grant-in-aid every year to carry out its functions. 23 number of Association have been recognized. Funding for National and Zonal Championship participation and cash award to winners of international and National level sports events.

Rajiv Gandhi School of Sports

An autonomous institution fully funded by Government. 100 young students (6th to12th) having special sports skill are selected and accommodated in the Rajiv Gandhi School of Sports and continue to get the special coaching in the games like Football, Hockey, Volleyball, Athletic and Badminton. The students pursue their studies in the urban area schools. Nutritional food at ₹.80/- per day per student is spent. This School prepares the students for participation in National competitions. 15 acres of land has been allotted in Kalapet revenue village for the construction of building for Rajiv Gandhi School of Sports.

- In line with the national goal of School Education, Government of Puducherry has been taking necessary steps to implement the Right of children to free and compulsory Education Act to achieve universal Elementary Education in the age group 0-14 years. The Act mandates unaided private schools to reserve upto 25 percent of seats for students from weaker sections, In this regard, a new scheme namely "Reimbursement of tuition fees and provision of other facilities due to implementation of Right to Education (RTE) Act" has been evolved for taking care of allocation on Government side.
- Special efforts will be made to identify habitations with infrastructure gaps, and for making appropriate allocations to bridge the gaps, namely construction of additional classrooms, Strengthening of libraries, Purchase of science kits, Appointment of teachers, etc.
- In response to the increased completion rate in Elementary Education, the number of Secondary and Higher Secondary schools and participation of students at these levels is continuously increasing. With the increase in growth of schools, and in enrolment, the number of teachers is also increasing. Hence, the posts of additional teachers will be created.
- Further, It is proposed to upgrade the schools to the next higher standards in order to reduce dropouts and to ensure continuity in the learning process of the students and to accommodate all the students in the secondary and higher secondary level consequent to the stress given in the Primary and Middle Level through various incentive schemes of State. During the 12th Five Year Plan (2012-17) in order to reduce the drop outs and to ensure continuity in the

learning process of the students it is proposed to upgrade 20 Nos of Primary Schools into Middle Schools, 9 Nos. of Middle Schools into High Schools and 9 Nos. of High Schools into Higher Secondary Schools. Due to these upgradation of schools, additional infrastructure are required to be provided. Construction of additional classrooms for 38 schools are proposed to be taken up in order to cope up with the upgradation and to take up other construction works of the schools in the existing old school buildings.

- The scheme of ICT in schools will be strengthened in order contribute significantly to the present day skill shortage.
- Improvement in the quality of education will be ensured through conduct of inservice trainings and orientation courses for teachers.
- Establishment of SCERT in the Union Territory of Puducherry.
- To achieve 100% literacy at the end of the Twelfth Five Year Plan. The literacy rate of the Union Territory of Puducherry as per the 2001 census was 81.24% and 2011 census was
- 86.50%. It is proposed to achieve 100% literacy at the end of the 12th Five Year Plan
- ▶ (2012-17) by implementing Kamarajar Literacy Mission from the year 2012-13.
- In the Union Territory of Puducherry, there are 433 State Government Schools, of which primary schools are 251, Middle Schools 52, High Schools 73, Higher Secondary Schools 56 and one Junior College at yanam.
- Land acquisition and construction of additional classrooms are proposed to be taken up during the 12th Five Year Plan in order to cope up with the upgradation of schools.
- Creation and appointment of more numbers of teachers taking into consideration the upgradation to next higher standards and opening of new sections in the schools. The quality of education can be improved substantially by bringing down the student teachers ratio. The increase in the number of teachers would ensure personal attention of teachers on the students.
- Introduction of Vocational courses in 10 more Higher Secondary Schools through creating new avenues in school education.
- Establishment of Vocational Educational cell.
- Strengthening of Academic Cell.

- Achieving e-networking of schools and Inspectorates with the Directorate of School Education to facilitate the communication accessible efficiently without lapse of time.
- > Formation of a separate Directorate of Sports and Youth Affairs.
- Construction of new building for Rajiv Gandhi School of Sports at Kalapet.
- Construction of Mini Stadium at various places
- Strengthening of Puducherry State Sports Council, Rajiv Gandhi School of Sports, and Youth Hostel.
- > Construction of one International Standard Cricket Stadium
- Conduct of various sports programmes and purchase of sports articles for distribution of all school at U.T. of Puducherry.
- Construction of Central Kitchens at 5 places.

ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2007-11

- The Government of Puducherry attaches utmost importance to achieve 100% enrolment and retention of children in Government schools by taking various measures. In order to achieve this goal the Government is providing Text books, Note Books, Stationery items, Uniforms and Footwear free of cost to all the students studying from LKG to XII Standard in all Government and Government-Aided Private Schools irrespective of the annual parental income ceiling limit in all regions of the Union Territory of Puducherry. 1,46,000 students were benefited under the Free Supply Scheme.
- ➤ The scheme of provision of transport facilities at concessional rate of ₹1/- per trip for all students of Government / Government Aided/Private Schools and Colleges in the "Students Special Buses" is under implementation with effect from 26.01.2010 to facilitate students to reach schools easily and back home throughout the academic year. 40 buses for school students and 15 buses for college students are plying in Puducherry region and 10 buses for school students and 5 buses for college students are plying in Karaikal region.
- During the period 2007-11, 4 Nos. of Primary Schools have been upgraded into Middle Schools, 18 Nos. of middle schools have been upgraded into high schools and 14 nos. of high schools have been upgraded into higher sec. schools.

- During 2010-11, the newly constructed Modern indoor Stadium at Yanam has been inaugurated on 27th November 2010.
- Construction of another indoor stadium at Mahe has been inaugurated on 14th February 2011.
- > Construction of indoor stadium at Karaikal is under progress.
- In order to encourage the Sports and Youth activities in Puducherry, renovation of the Rajiv Gandhi indoor Stadium has been taken up at a cost of ₹7.50 crores.
- A mega Science Exhibition by name Southern India Science Exhibition /Drama Festival has been conducted in Puducherry by the Directorate of School Education for a period of five days from 20th to 24th January 2011 at Vivekananda Higher Secondary School, Sellaperumalpet, Lawspet, Puducherry in collaboration with the Visveswaraya Industrial and technological Museum, Bangalore. Students from Southern States participated. Chief Minister's Special Cash award of ₹50,000/- was awarded for overall best exhibit of Southern India Science Fair for the first time.
- I0 Students of Puducherry were selected to visit Japan through "JENESYS" programme during the academic year 2009-10.
- Cash Awards of ₹1.00 lakhs have been presented to Govt. Schools which achieved 100% result in urban areas and above 90% result in rural areas in the Public Examination of SSLC & Higher Secondary held in 2010.
- Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA), with its aim to improve the quality of elementary education, was under implementation in the U.T. of Pondicherry with 65 per cent grant from Government of India and 35 per cent state share.
- Rasthitriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA) was also under implementation for the development of Secondary Education with funding pattern of 75% grant from Government of India and 25% State Share of the Union Territory of Puducherry. Under this programme, 116 Government Schools having Secondary sections were given Annual School grant of ₹40,000/-. Minor repair grant of ₹25,000/- was given to 116 schools. All Secondary Teachers handling IX and X will be trained for a minimum of 5 days per year. Further, each school will be provided with a separate room for science lab, computer, arts & crafts room and library room. Initially 24 schools have

been selected for 2009-10 and another 24 schools were selected for 2010-11 and another 24 schools for 2011-12.

- Next to Delhi Administration, only in U.T. of Puducherry, Govt. schools were provided with internet (Broad Band) facilities and the same are connected with World Wide Web (WWW). These facilities were provided in 244 Govt. Primary Schools and 64 Govt. High Schools in all four regions with an estimated cost of ₹14,03,248/-.
- In 21 Govt. schools Satellite Interactive Terminals (SIT) were installed with the financial assistance from ISRO/Department of Information Technology and a studio especially for UT of Puducherry is functioning in SSA office, Education Department with dedicated connection to Anna University.
- > ABL new method of teaching was introduced in Primary schools.
- All Primary Schools & Middle schools were provided with Computers.
- Scholarships were given to Economically Backward Class Students. About 20,000 students were benefited.
- Incentive awards were given to students belonging to the poor and weaker section of the Society. About 1700 students benefited.
- Cash awards were presented to the top ranking students selected in the National Talent Search (NTS) Examination. ₹10,000 will be awarded for one student selected at National Level and ₹5000 for 10 students selected at the State Level.
- Public Examination fees were paid for the benefit of 21,340 students belonging to Government Schools who appeared for SSLC and Higher Secondary public examination.

HIGHER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION

The Directorate of Higher & Technical Education was bifurcated from the erstwhile Directorate of Education during 2003 to set up a separate establishment for dealing with the matters pertaining to the Higher Education. The Government of Puducherry, to impart quality higher education has established various colleges in the Government sector and also under various Societies. Apart from this, private initiative in the field of higher education also being encouraged by this Government by providing No Objection Certificate for Private Managements to start Arts & Science Colleges and Professional Colleges.

There is one Central University by the name of "**Pondicherry University**" located at Kalapet. Most of the Government Arts & Science Colleges, Professional Colleges, and Engineering & Medical colleges are affiliated to Pondicherry University. It also offers various PG/M.Phil/Research programmes in its campus. During the financial year 2010-11, the **National Institute of Technology** is started in Karaikal which offers wide exposure to our students.

There are seven Government Arts & Science Colleges and one Govt. Polytechnic college in the U.T. of Puducherry as detailed below:

The main function of this Directorate is to deal with the service matters of the Lecturers, their career progression and providing infrastructure facilities to the colleges.

Allocation of seats in various professional colleges in other States for the students of U.T. of Puducherry and sponsoring of students to the seats reserved in other states for various Medical /Engg/ and Diploma Courses through **CENTAC**. Similarly admission of students for

Arts and Science Courses in Puducherry region through **CAPASC** (Centralised Admission Procedure for Arts and Science Courses).

Starting of new colleges, sending proposals to Govt. for approval and issue of NOC for starting private professional, Engineering, Arts & Science College, B.Ed., College and starting of new courses etc.

SCHOLARSHIPS

In order that no meritorious students is prevented on grounds of financial constraint from an academic career in the field of Medical, Engineering, etc., the Govt. of Puducherry has introduced financial assistance scheme viz "**Perunthalaivar Kamarajar Financial Assistance Scheme**" to reimburse the Tuition Fee to the students selected through CENTAC studying Medical /Engineering courses in the private unaided professional institutions. Tution fees have been waived in the Govt. Professional Colleges. Similarly scholarships have been awarded to the students studying Arts, Science and Technical courses based on the merit list.

PRESENT SCENARIO IN BUDGET

Puducherrys' Higher Education system has been a huge pillar of strength to the Puducherry Economy. It has provided a highly educated local work force and also has been a major centre of learning for people from outside the Union Territory. Hence more investments are made in this Sector during the years. After the implementation of the 6th Central Pay Commissions' recommendations, there has been huge increase in the financial commitment towards payment of salaries. Hence the funds allotted under this sector have been mostly spent for payment of salaries.

VISION AND MISSION

The desire of the local inhabitants of Puducherry who equate knowledge with wealth is making Puducherry a knowledge hub. The tireless effort of the people of Puducherry to transform this tiny Union Territory into a knowledge society is bearing fruit already. Puducherry is proving that it is not the size of the state that determines the no. of academic institutions but the desire of the people ably supported by the efforts of the Govt. which matters in providing quality education. The setting up of Govt. Medical College in Puducherry and National Institute of Technology in Karaikal are the unforgettable milestones in this tireless mission. Our vision is to make this journey forward by providing 100% access, enrollment in Higher Education and to give ample opportunities to the students for their better career. Our mission is to empower the youth to choose and lead a life appropriate to his talents by ensuring facilities for Higher Education to all those who pass their School Education.

- Education is the critical factor that will empower the poor to participate in the growth process. To ensure a continuous and growing supply of quality of man power, we need large investments in public sector Institutions of higher learning combined with fundamental reforms of curriculum.
- With the starting of National Institute of Technology at Karaikal and with the prospects of establishing Puducherry State University along with 2 Engineering Colleges, 11 Arts and Science Colleges, 6 Polytechnic Colleges, 1 Community College, 1 B.Ed.
