CO-OPERATIVE

To provide financial assistance to the Pondicherry State Cooperative Housing Federation Ltd., Pondicherry Cooperative Building Centre and Primary Co-operative Housing Societies functioning in the Union Territory of Puducherry.

ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2007-11

Under the scheme a sum of ₹511.92 lakhs was released to housing co-operatives towards share capital to the Pondicherry Co-operative Building Centre, Karaikal Co-operative Building Society, Mahe Co-operative Housing Society and Yanam Co-operative Housing Society. A sum of ₹1011.98 lakhs has been provided a subsidy/grant to 25 primary Co-operative Housing Societies and nearly 500 members were the beneficiaries under the scheme "Interest Subsidy".

PROPOSED TARGETS FOR 2012-13

It is proposed to give share capital assistance to the Pondicherry State Co-operative Housing Federation, Pondicherry Co-operative Building Centre, Karaikal Co-operative Building Society and Primary Co-operative Housing Societies and subsidy to 35 Primary Co-operative Housing Societies.
- An amount of ₹3839.50 lakhs has been earmarked under Housing Sector for the XII Five Year Plan to provide financial assistance in the form of Share capital and interest subsidy @ 4% to SC members and 3% interest rebate to all the members other than SC members, setting up of fly ash brick making unit, construction of apartments, purchase of land, construction of office building, promotion of flats etc.,

TOWN & COUNTRY PLANNING

Housing is one of the basic human needs for a decent existence. It is not only a basic need but also an instrument of change to generate income to provide safe living environment and to increase productivity. A roof over one's head in a planned layout is the most important step towards 'Housing' for all.

As per 2011 census, the population of the Union Territory is 12,44,464. Out of this, the urban population is 8,50,123 which is 68% to the total population, and the rural population is 3,94,341 which is 31% to the total population. The number of residential houses in the U.T. Puducherry is 2,04,806 as per 2001 census. The population projected for the year 2012 works out to 13,44,000 and projected housing demand by 2012 is 1,30,000. Out of this, the urban housing demand is 91,000 and rural housing demand is 39,000.

The Govt. of Puducherry is endeavoured to make the Union Territory as hutless and slum free Union Territory by implementing various housing schemes. Apropos of making the U.T. as hutless one, the Government of Puducherry has introduced a Scheme "Perunthalaivar Kamaraj Centenary Housing (Shelter for Houseless Poor) Scheme with a view to provide financial assistance to about 55,000 houseless Below Poverty Line (BPL) families for converting their huts into R.C.C. roofed houses. Under this scheme, upto Phase IV, financial assistance has been extended to 32,500 BPL families. Under Phase V of the scheme, 1st instalment has been extended to 15,000 BPL families and 2nd instalment has been extended to 5,000 BPL families. It is proposed to extend the balance instalments and also to cover the remaining houseless BPL families in the 12th Five Year Plan. Taking into account the cost escalation of all building materials, it is proposed to increase the financial assistance of ₹1.00 lakhs.

The Ministry of Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation has also introduced a new scheme "Rajiv Awas Yojana" to bring the existing slums within the formal system and enabling them to avail the same level of basic amenities as the rest of the town. The main aim of the scheme is to assign property rights to people rights living in slum area and to create a slum free India in next five years.

The Rajiv Awas Yojana requires developing a robust database on slums which is critical for implementation and in order to prepare a Slum Free City Plan of Action, the Ministry of Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation has approved a fully Centrally Sponsored Scheme viz., "Slum Free City Planning". Survey of all slum, household and livelihood surveys in each of the slum will be done using GIS software and database will be integrated with the online MIS system developed by National Building Organization. Plan of Action for developing each of the slums will be prepared and based on the missing facilities of housing and infrastructure, Detailed Project Reports will be submitted during the 12th Five Year Plan to avail the fund under Rajiv Awas Yojana. It is proposed to meet out the State Schemes like a) "Slum Uprgradation Programme" and b) "Environmental Improvements in Urban Slums" being implemented by the Town and Country Planning Department through the Puducherry Slum Clearance Board. The Rajiv Awas Yojana will be implemented with a vision to declare entire U.T of Puducherry as "Slum Free Union Territory" by the end of 12th Five Year Plan. Further, with a view to disseminating Environment Friendly and Cost Effective Building Construction Technology, it is proposed

to impart training to 1,000 Nos. of semi skilled and skilled artisans / masons through the Building Centres in the U.T. Puducherry.

- Under Phase VI of the Scheme, the Subsidy Amount will be ₹2,00,000/- per Beneficiary in 3 installments @ ₹ 70,000/-, ₹60,000/- and ₹70,000/-. Under which, 2400 beneficiaries will be provided 1st installment of ₹ 70,000/- to each.
- Administrative charges to the Puducherry Slum Clearance Board at the rate of 3% of the amount released for implementing the scheme
- The approved 1136 dwelling units will be completed and handed over to beneficiaries with infrastructure facilities of water supply, sewerage, Community hall, internal roads, ration shop, Anganwadi at Lambert Saravanan Nagar. The remaining infrastructure facilities of rain water harvesting, fire fighting arrange ments, parks and open spaces will be taken up.
- The Kuruchikuppam project will be completed in all respects with all the infrastructure facilities. Steps will be taken up to de-notify the slum.
- Construction of remaining 1398 dwelling units for SC beneficiaries at the remaining layouts will be taken up with infrastructure facilities after completion of land acquisition proceedings.
- 216 dwelling units at Karaikovilpathu will be completed and handed over to beneficiaries with infrastructure works of water supply, sewerage, internal roads, community hall, drains, revetments and compound wall. A Housing Demand Survey will be conducted in the U.T. of Puducherry in order to assess the Houseless BPL families.

- Detailed Project Report for Pilot Project will be prepared as per the Slum Free City Plan to provide missing facilities and action will be initiated for implementation of the project.
- A Slum Free City Plan will be prepared and action plan will be prepared to provide all missing facilities in the slums of Puducherry in a whole slum approach as per 7-Point charter.

SURVEY AND LAND RECORDS

To distribute free house-sites to the poor landless labourers in rural areas at free of cost by acquiring land under Land Acquisition.

ADI-DRAVIDAR WELFARE

Financial assistance for the construction of low cost dwelling units are distributed to SC people. To provide better housing a housing subsidy of ₹ 2,00,000 is given to SC people whose annual income is not more than ₹ 2,00,000. The subsidy is distributed in three installments. Now the housing subsidy is enhanced to ₹ 4,00,000 lakhs.

ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2007-11

Housing subsidy at the rate of ₹1 lakh & ₹2 lakh each (in three instalments) are given to 7700 SC (BPL) families.

LIKELY ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2011-12

An amount of ₹2 lakh is being granted as House Construction Subsidy and 2178 homeless SC people are benefited.

PROPOSED TARGETS FOR 2012-13

- 2,050 families are proposed to be covered under the scheme of construction of low cost dwelling units / development of housing colonies / house sites and grant of house construction subsidies at the rate of Rs.2.00 lakh each in three instalments.
- ▶ In future the subsidy shall be enhanced to Rs.4.00 lakh each in three instalments.

DRDA

The IAY programme was implemented in the U.T of Pondicherry with effect from 1996-97. The main objective of the scheme is to provide houses free of cost to BPL families in the rural areas and also assist in the healthy development of the habitat in these areas. Under State's share of IAY, a Subsidy of \gtrless 1,00,000 is given for BPL beneficiaries for construction of a house. The Central Govt. share of IAY will be \gtrless 45,000/- State's share of IAY will be \gtrless 55,000/-. The subsidy will be given in four installments. The assistance is given to the BPL families who are having own Patta of 215 Sq.ft. for construction of Pucca houses.

It has been decided that the central subsidy available under IAY will be dovetailed with the Housing schemes operated by U.T. through Slum Clearance Board and Adi-dravidar Welfare Department and the beneficiaries in the IAY list only will be assisted.

On par with other state housing schemes, under IAY also, ₹1.00 lakh is being given the house construction subsidy (Central subsidy @ ₹ 45,000/- and State Subsidy @ ₹55,000/-) GOI has fixed the higher target every year. But in view of scarcity of funds, the State administration could not spare matching subsidy to the higher targets fixed by GOI for the last five years. This year it has been decided to maintain the target of 75 houses only even though GOI has fixed higher target for 2012-13. However to achieve the desired target level, dovetailing the Central subsidy with State housing programmes has been worked out Adi Dravidar welfare Department and Slum Clearance Board will get ₹45,000/- Central subsidy by DRDA to the beneficiaries whose name exist in IAY wait list.
