

WELFARE OF SCHEDULED CASTES

The Adi-draavidar Welfare Department is implementing schemes under two categories to SC population in order to improve quality of life and to ensure the human dignity of life.

In order to give quality education, schemes are implemented for improving the education level, to impart training and self employment to the SC population which are ultimately lead to better socio economic status.

In order to uplift the SC population, schemes focusing on overall socio economic development of the SC population are being implemented by the department.

Schemes for Educational improvements, training & self –employment:

- Pre- matric Scholarship are awarded to the eligible SC students studying at Middle and High School stage enabling them to complete their education.
- Post- matric Scholarship are awarded to students to enable them to complete their education at post matriculation / post secondary level.
- Opportunity cost are being paid to parents of SC students in order to eliminate child labour and encourage the parents to send their girl children to educational institutions.
- A separate scholarship scheme exclusively for the SC students in the name of Dr. Ambedkar Financial Assistance is proposed to be implemented for providing financial assistance SC students pursuing higher education.
- Presently 28 boys and girls hostels are functioning in all the three regions with requisite infrastructure facilities.
- It is proposed to supply Lap-top at free of cost to SC students studying MCA courses in the current financial year.

Schemes for Socio – Economic Development:

- Free House site pattas are given to the poor homeless SC people enabling them to construct their own houses.

- To provide better housing, a housing subsidy of ₹4,00,000/- is proposed to be given to SC people towards construction of dwelling units.
- Financial assistance to the extent of ₹25,000/- are granted to SC parents for performing marriages to their daughters.
- 10,000 SC families will be benefitted by free supply of Washing Machines in the current financial year.
- For providing basic amenities such as roads, drinking water, drainage, path way to burial ground, construction of cremation sheds, water borne latrines in SC colonies, grants are given to local bodies.
- Free clothing items are distributing to 2,52,000 SC people twice in a year.
- PADCO is a Public Sector Undertaking, is given Grant-in-aid to extent financial assistance to SC population for setting up trade / industry so as to create self employment.
- It is also proposed to impart training among SC educated and unemployed youths for developing their skills.

ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2007-11

- 36,415 SC students are awarded Pre-metric Scholarship.
- 13,718 SC students are awarded Post-Metric scholarship.
- 27,312 SC girls students are benefited by opportunity cost.
- Nearly 7,87,282 SC people are given free clothing items.
- 11,880 SC Poor brides, pregnant and lactating, women, persons suffering from prolonged disease and to perform funeral rites.
- 751 SC students pursuing Professional courses selected through CENTAC were awarded financial assistance under PTKFAS.
- Grant-in-aid to various Local Bodies to take up 362 civic works in the SC concentrated areas.
- Presently, out of 28 hostels, 12 Hostels are running in private buildings. Necessary proposal was sent to Government of India to avail fund under CSS for

construction three more new hostels so that all hostels will run in government buildings.

- All the facilities (Boarding & Lodging including Non-diet items) for the hostels students are made available periodically.
- The Scholarship issued to the students has been increased twice than the present one.
- Travelling Allowance at ₹ 20/- per day to IV year and V year Law Students staying at Government SC Hostels are paid.
- Educational Tour has also been arranged to XII Std., and II year ITI students and final year of college students staying at Government SC Hostels.
- Nearly 3,335 inmates are benefited with Hostel facilities.
- Under the scheme of purchase, distribution and development of house sites 319 homeless persons are allotted free house site pattas

LIKELY ACHIEVEMENTS DURING 2011-12

- Nearly, 8,300 SC girls students would be benefited under the scheme Opportunity Cost.
- About, 2,60,000 SC beneficiaries would be covered under the scheme, “Free supply of clothing items”.
- Purchase, distribution and development of house sites for 50 families are proposed to be covered, for which land acquisition process is under anvil.
- It is proposed to cover 4,300 persons under the scheme of financial assistance to the parent of poor SC brides, pregnant & lactating women and SC patients suffering from prolonged diseases.
- About 8,500 students would be benefitted under Pre-matric scholarship.
- About 3,500 students under Post-matric scholarship would be benefited.
- About, 25 centres would be opened for setting up of tuition centres for coaching the SC students under the scheme Coaching & Allied facilities.
- Nearly, 150 SC students studying Professional Courses would be benefited under the scheme Financial Assistance to SC students sponsored by CENTAC.

- It has been proposed to construct a Model Village covering 1660 houses at the first instalment with all basic infrastructures by availing Loan from HUDCO.

PROPOSED TARGETS FOR 2012-13

- About, 2,65,000 SC beneficiaries would be covered under the scheme, “Free supply of clothing items”.
- Purchase, distribution and development of house sites for 50 families are proposed to be covered, for which land acquisition process is under anvil.
- It is proposed to cover 4,000 persons under the scheme of financial assistance to the parent of poor SC brides, pregnant & lactating women and SC patients suffering from prolonged diseases.
- About 9,050 students under Pre-metric scholarship would be benefited.
- Nearly, 9,000 SC girls students would be benefited under the scheme Opportunity Cost.
- About 4,000 students under Post-metric scholarship would be benefited.
- About, 5,000 SC students would be covered by opening 100 tuition centres under the scheme Coaching & Allied facilities.
- Nearly, 150 SC students studying Professional Courses would be benefited under the scheme Financial Assistance to SC students sponsored by CENTAC.
- It is proposed to cover 200 students under the scheme Free supply of Computers.
- Grant-in-aid to various Local Bodies to take up 50 civic works in the SC concentrated areas.
- Distribution of washing machine to SC families.
- Distribution of laptops to SC students.
