#### **AGRICULTURE**

The Department of Agriculture has taken a number of steps during the Eleventh Five Year Plan period in order to improve the agriculture productivity and status of the farmers in this U.T and to offset the crisis caused by the continued depletion of land and water resources and other problems such as labour scarcity and price decline for agricultural produce.

This Department has been implementing 12 schemes under the State Plan apart from Rastriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) with the Additional Central Assistance, aiming at convergence of agricultural and other allied activities. Implementation of other Centrally Sponsored Schemes such as Macro Management, National Horticulture Mission (NHM) and support to State Extension Programmes for Extension reforms – Agriculture Technology Management Agency (ATMA) are the initiatives taken by the Department.

Under the scheme Rastriya Krishi Vikas Yojana, the System of Rice Intensification (SRI) method of cultivation is promoted in Pondicherry and Karaikal regions. One sugarcane harvester with two tractors and three infielders have been purchased and placed at the disposal of the Pondicherry Co-operative sugar mill to mitigate the hardship faced by the sugarcane farmers due to the scarcity of labour for harvesting.

During the Annual Plan 2013-14, this department has planned to implement various activities viz. i) the Botanical Garden which was badly damaged due to cyclone Thane will be restored to its original glory by clearing the debris, repairing the civil structures and planting of new seedling, ii) construction of auction yards/ rural godowns will be taken up with the aid of the NABARD under the "Rural Infrastructure Development Fund (RIFD)", iii) towards the capacity building of agricultural labourers, it is proposed to send around 2,000 workers to Ananthapur (A.P.) for specialized training in operation and maintenance of farm equipments, iv) urban and pre-urban horticulture will be encouraged by providing purchase of inputs at 50 to 75% subsidy and thereby expected to encourage urban people to take up kitchen garden/cultivate vegetables, v) under the National Horticulture Mission, establishment of more poly houses will be taken up, which is expected to contribute for increased productivity vi) under the Rastriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) projects such as intensification of millets, pulses and oil seeds, strengthening of soil testing laboratories at Karaikal, establishment of Vermi Compost and Vermi Hatching Unit, Hi-tech nursery at Puducherry.
